

MAJOR MUNICIPAL RESERVOIR SYSTEM STORAGE

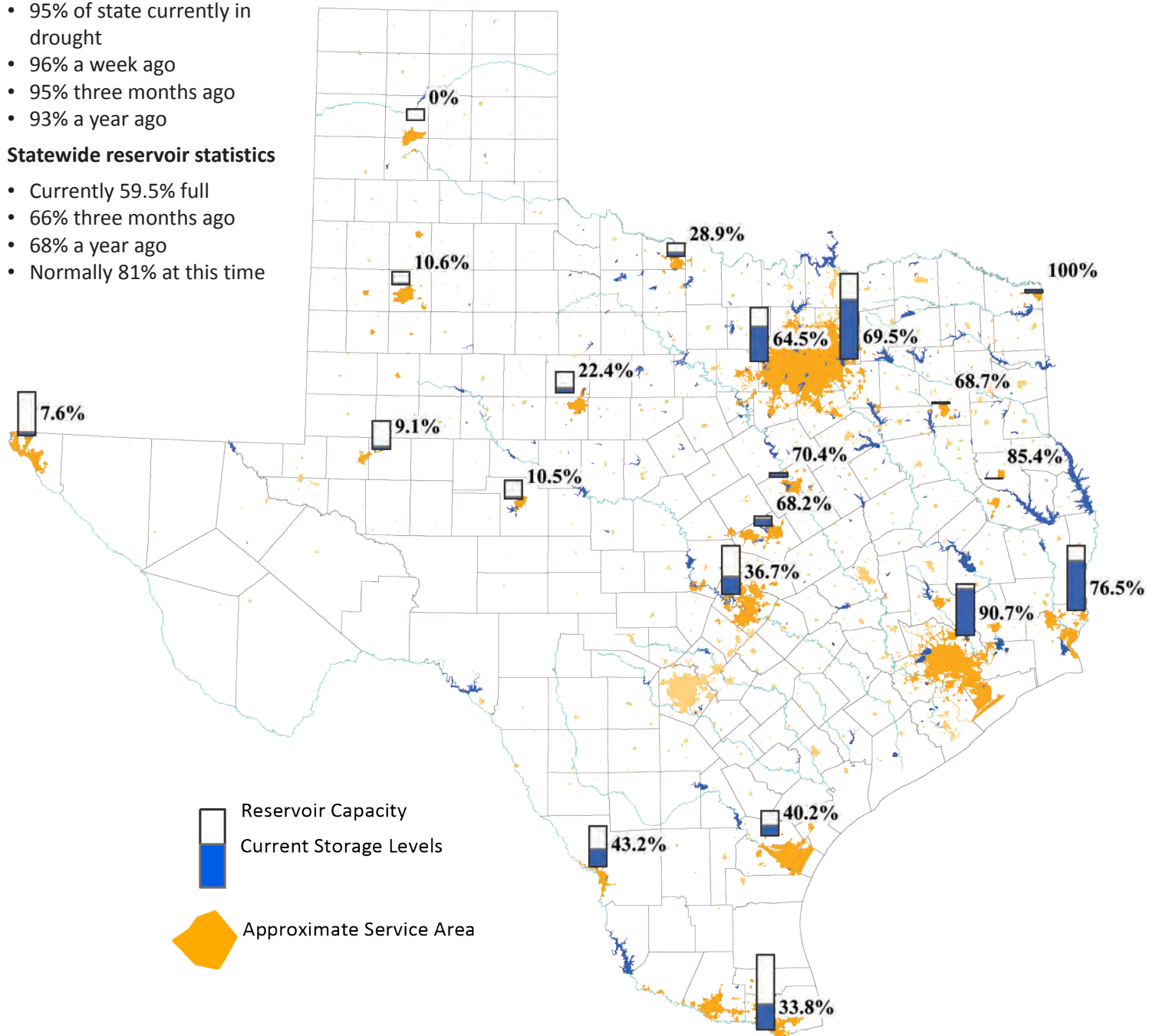
Last week was newsworthy for Texas' water supplies. On Thursday, statewide reservoir storage tied the record low of 58.4% full. Widespread rains late last week increased our water storage by a little over 1%. Despite this minimal gain, major municipal reservoir storage levels along and west of the I-35 and I-37 corridors remain significantly low.

Current drought statistics

- 95% of state currently in drought
- 96% a week ago
- 95% three months ago
- 93% a year ago

Statewide reservoir statistics

- Currently 59.5% full
- 66% three months ago
- 68% a year ago
- Normally 81% at this time
