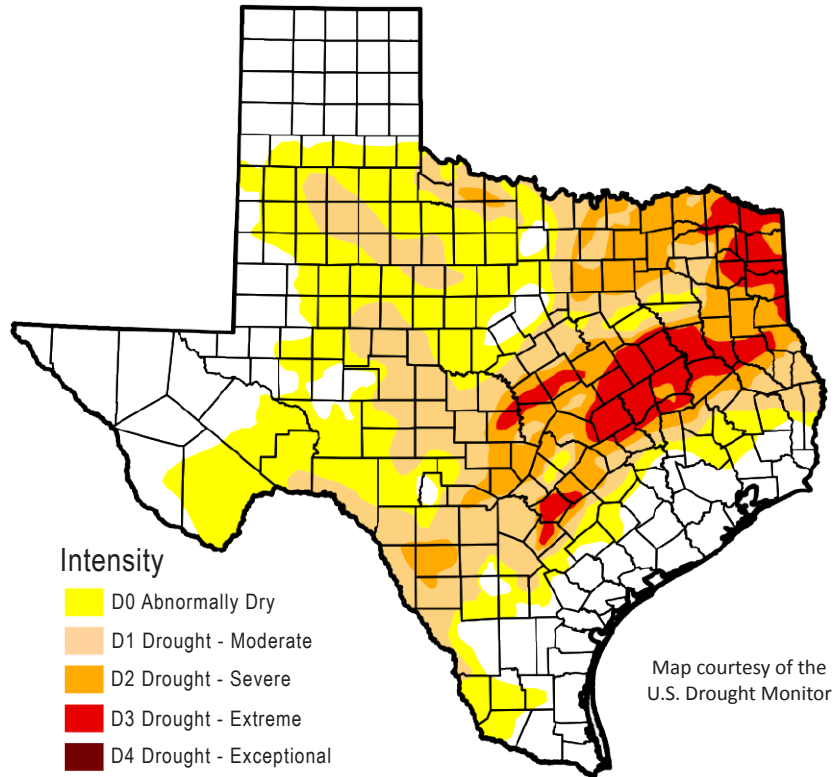


WATER CONDITIONS

Despite fall starting on September 23rd, summer weather continues to hang around. Over the past week, statewide reservoir levels declined by 175,000 acre-feet, and the amount of Texas in drought jumped from 30 to 38 percent. The National Weather Service expects October to be cooler and wetter than normal. Yes, please.

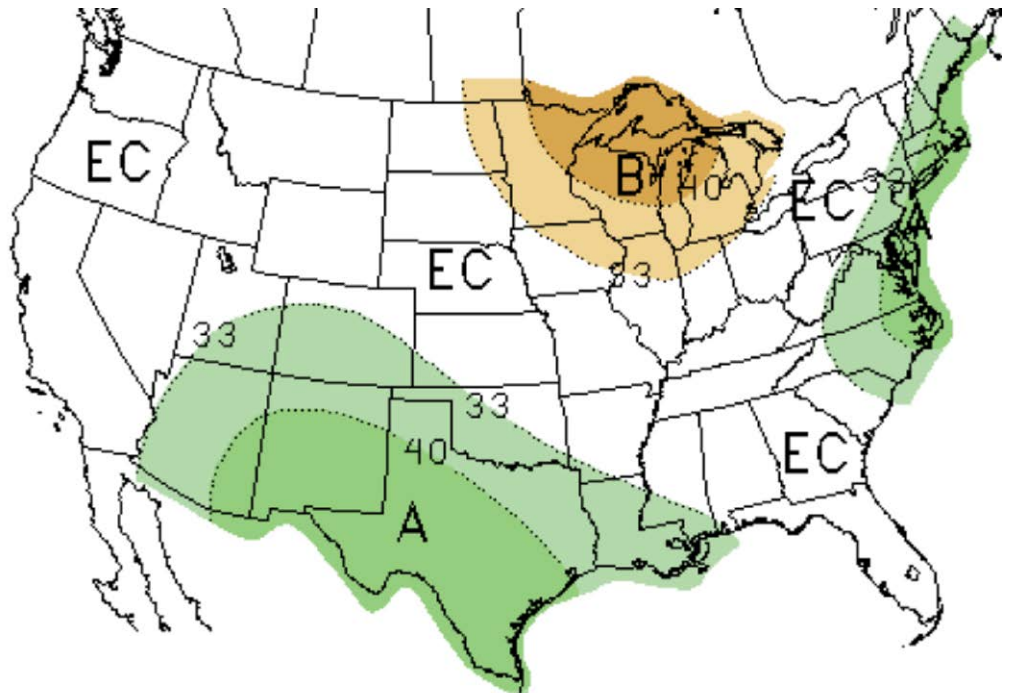
Drought conditions

- 38% now
- 30% a week ago
- 0.25% three months ago
- 49% a year ago



PRECIPITATION PROBABILITY

According to the National Weather Service, October should favor wetter-than-normal conditions.



EC means equal chances for A, N, B
A means Above
N means Normal
B means Below
