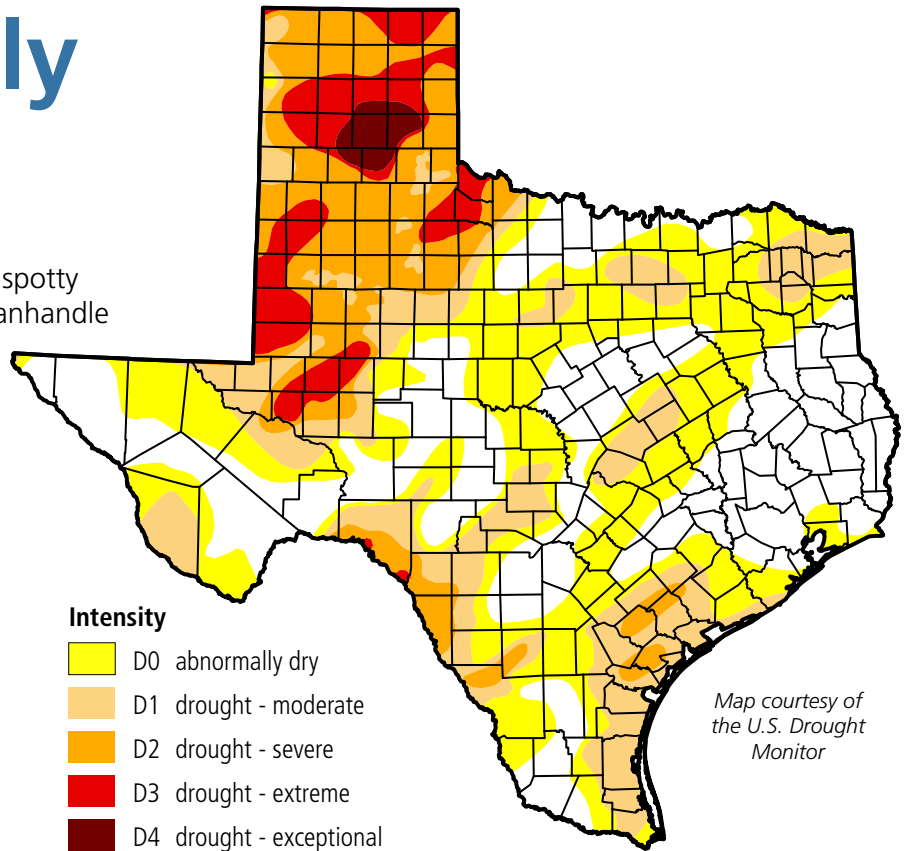

Water conditions

The latest drought map shows the results of spotty precipitation across the state. Areas of the Panhandle and West Texas showed improvement while conditions degraded in other areas. For the first time in three months, drought reemerged in East Texas.

Drought conditions

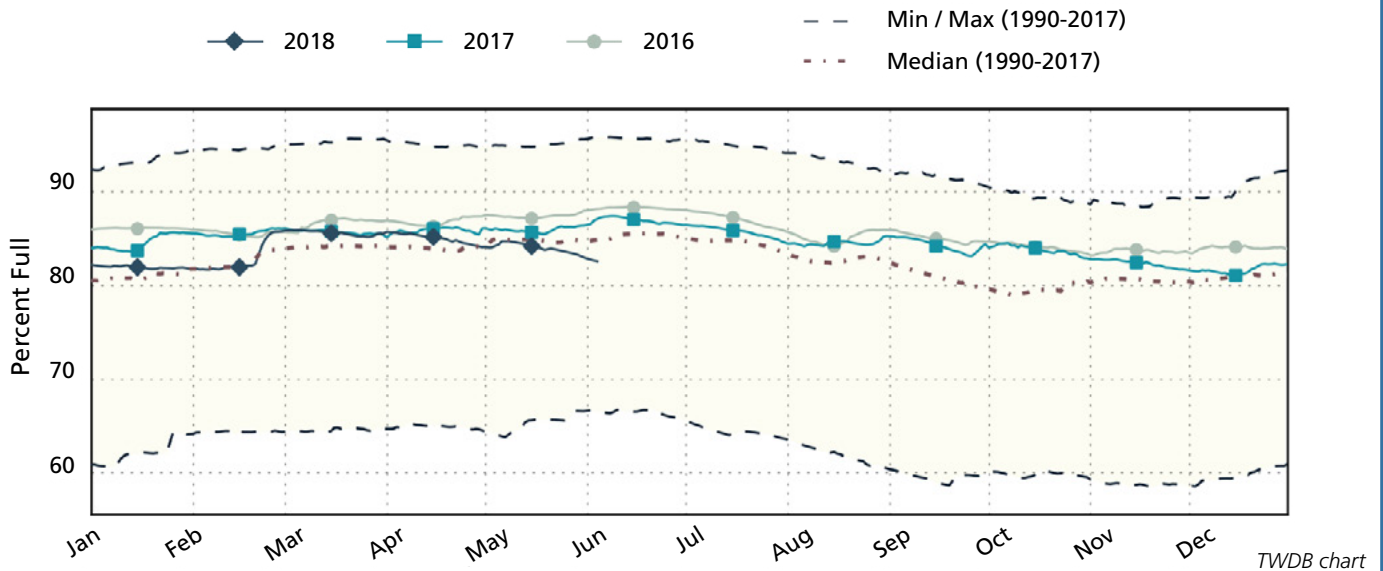
- ◆ 40% now
- ◆ 41% a week ago
- ◆ 55% three months ago
- ◆ 4% a year ago

Statewide reservoir storage

Drought conditions are beginning to impact our reservoirs. Statewide water supply storage, currently 83 percent of capacity, is nearly 2 percentage points below normal for this time of year. In February 2015, after years of drought, statewide storage was 18 percentage points lower than normal.
