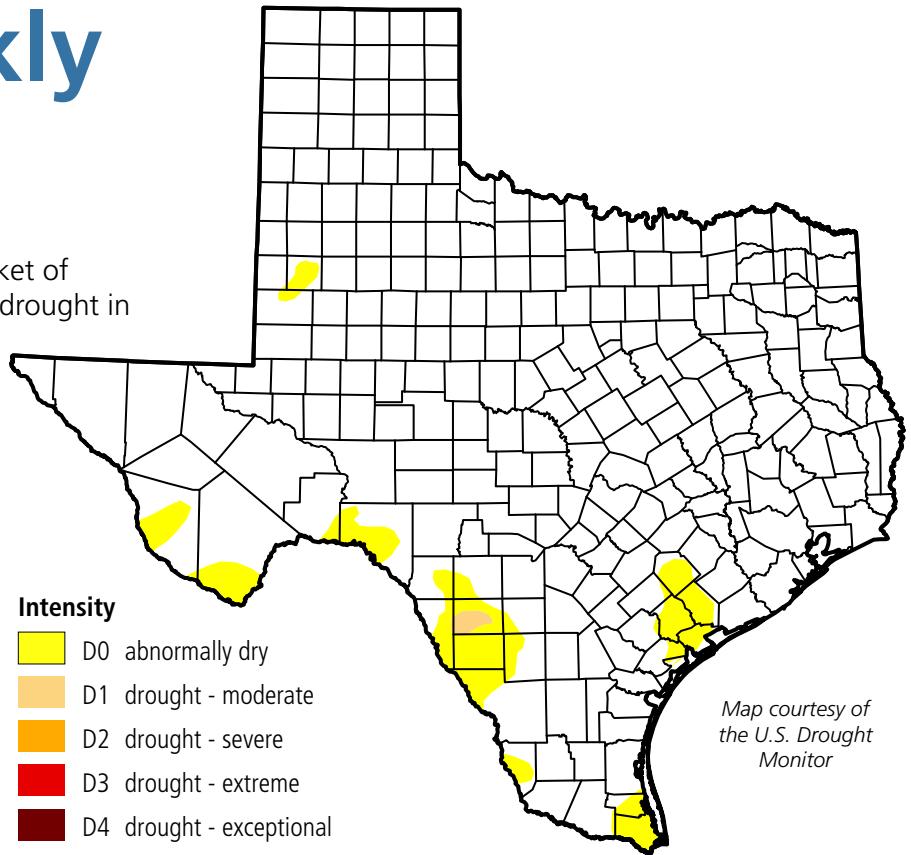

Water conditions

The latest drought map shows a small pocket of drought in Zavala County, the first area of drought in Texas in the last four weeks. Abnormally dry conditions, which could transition to drought in the next few weeks, now cover more than 5 percent of the state.

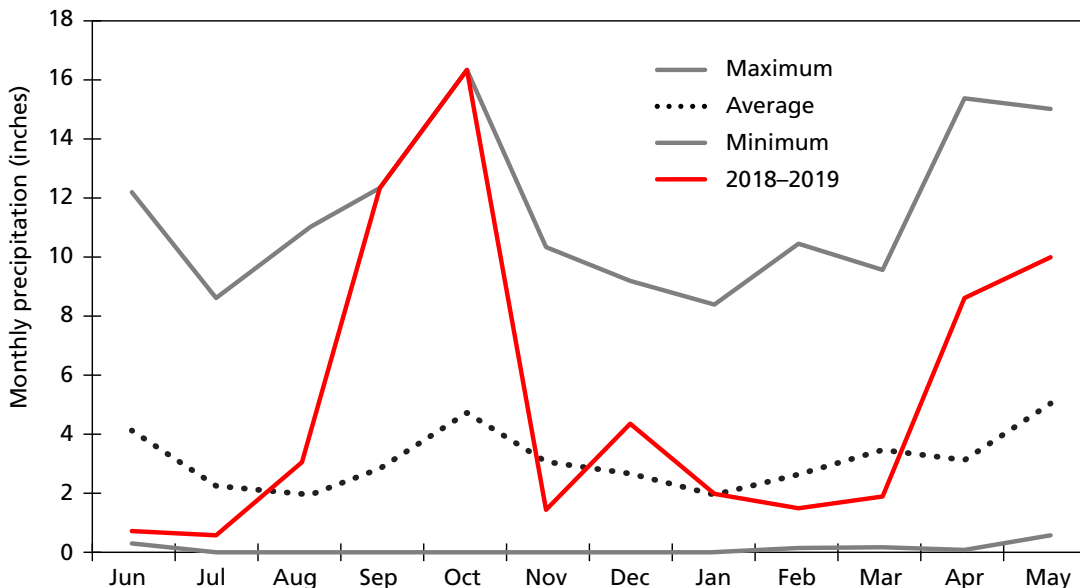
Drought conditions

Dallas precipitation

In an average 12-month June to May period, Dallas receives 37 inches of rainfall. For the 12-month period ending with May 2019, Dallas received a record 61.5 inches of rainfall. Dallas is poised to set similar 12-month rainfall records in June and July of this year.
