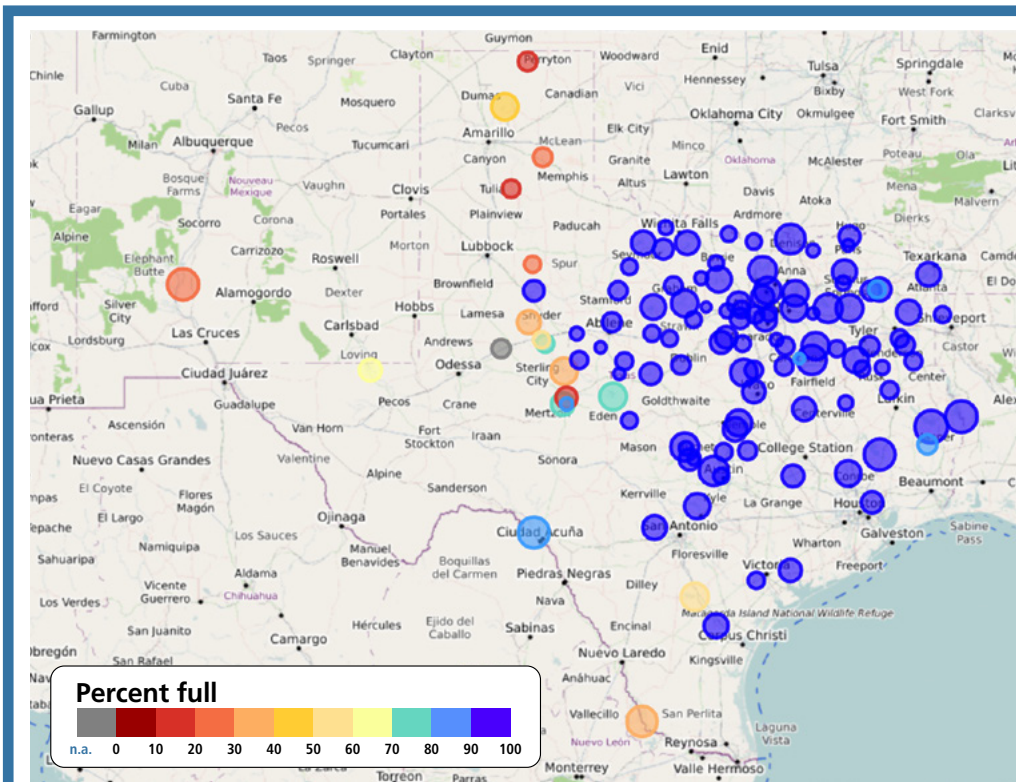
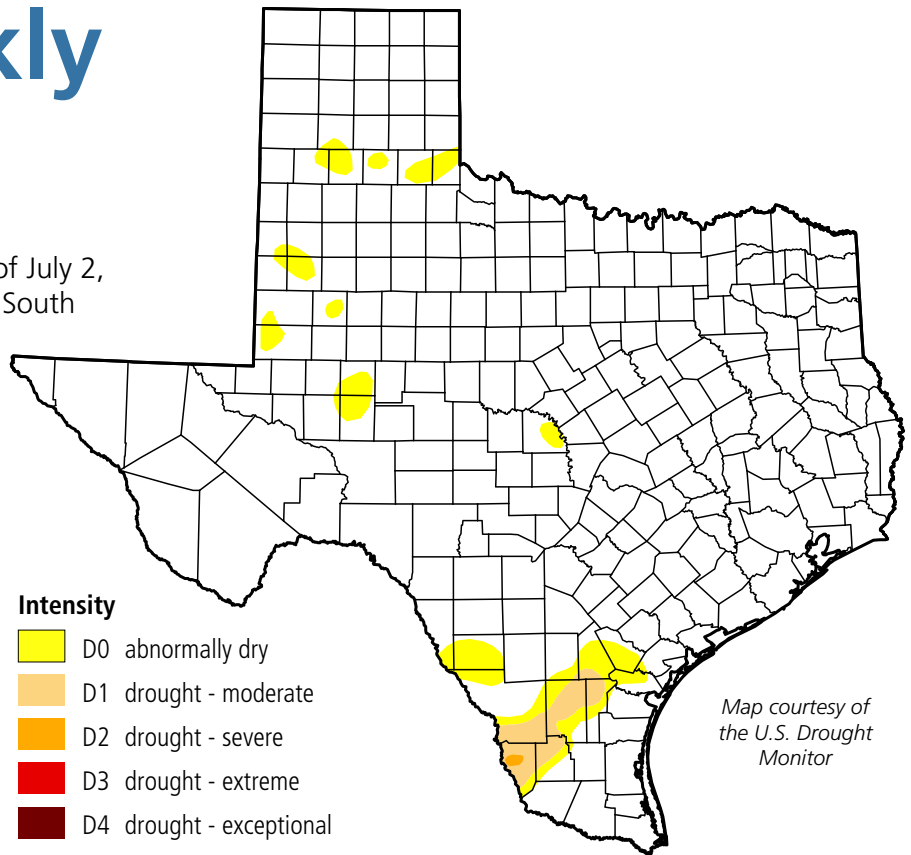

## Water conditions

The latest drought map, for conditions as of July 2, shows a modest contraction of drought in South Texas. Several pockets of abnormally dry conditions have developed in the Panhandle and Central Texas.

## Drought conditions

- ◆ 1% now
- ◆ 2% a week ago
- ◆ 12% three months ago
- ◆ 55% a year ago



## Water Data for Texas

### Statewide reservoir storage

In early July 2019, total storage in our water supply reservoirs is 90.1 percent of statewide capacity. That's more than 5 percentage points above normal for this time of year. Most reservoirs in the eastern half of the state are at or near water supply capacity.
