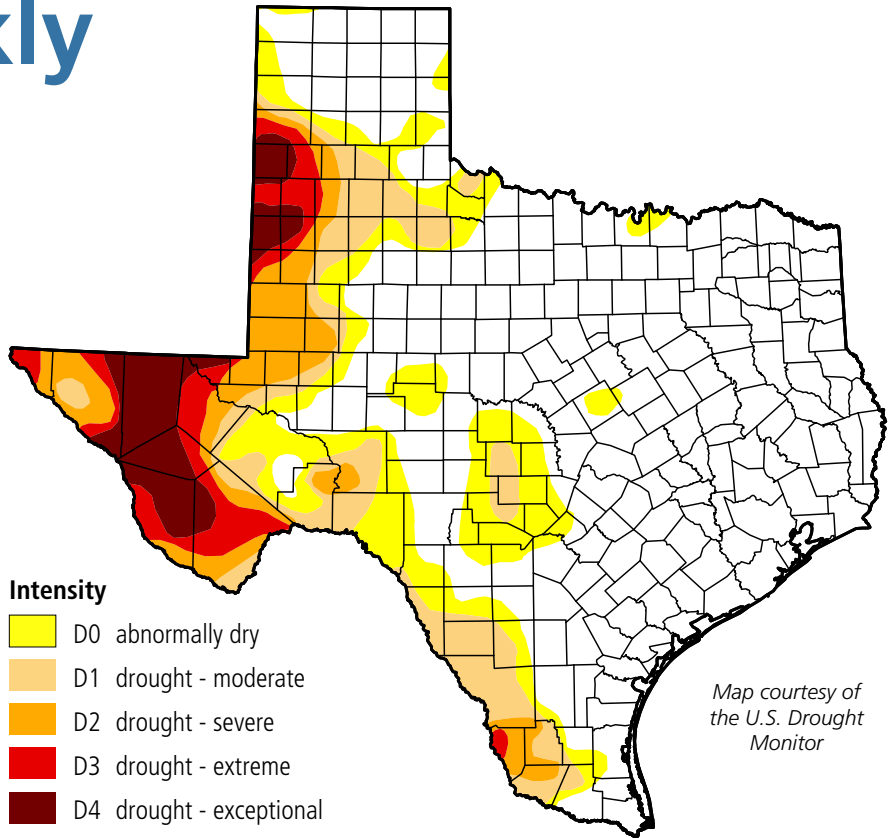

Water conditions

For the sixth consecutive week, the area of the state impacted by drought has declined. In that time, drought area has declined by 50 percentage points. The latest drought map for conditions as of May 25 shows the lowest area of the state in drought since July 2020.



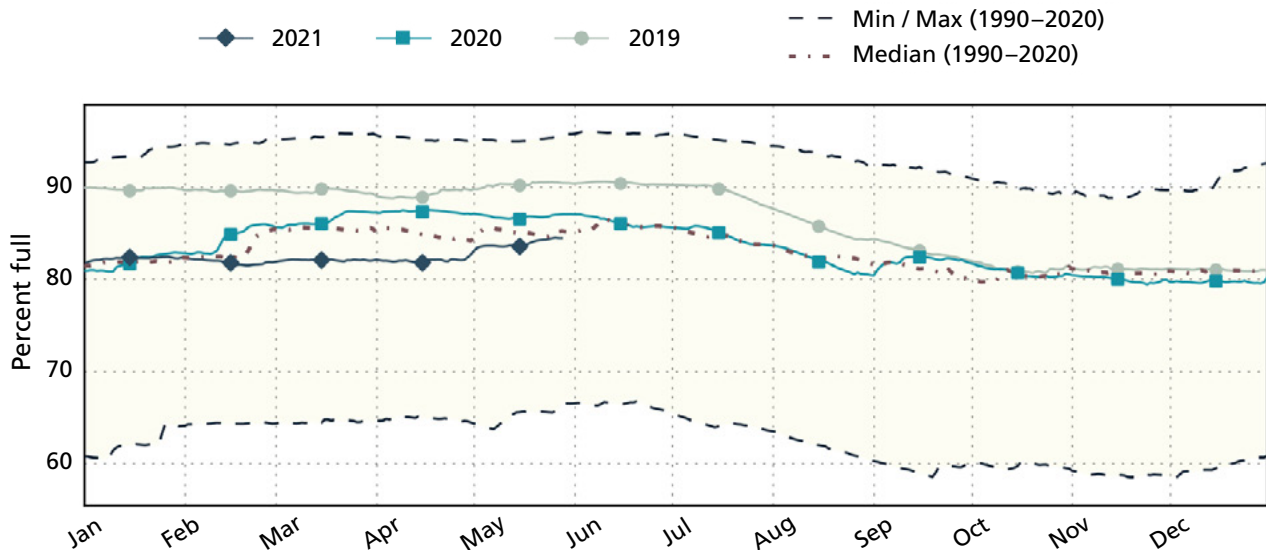
Drought conditions

- ◆ 25% now
- ◆ 33% a week ago
- ◆ 51% three months ago
- ◆ 8% a year ago

In mid-April, our water supply reservoirs were at 82 percent of capacity, three percentage points below normal for that time of year. At the end of May, they were near 84.5 percent of capacity, only half a percentage point less than normal for this time of year.
