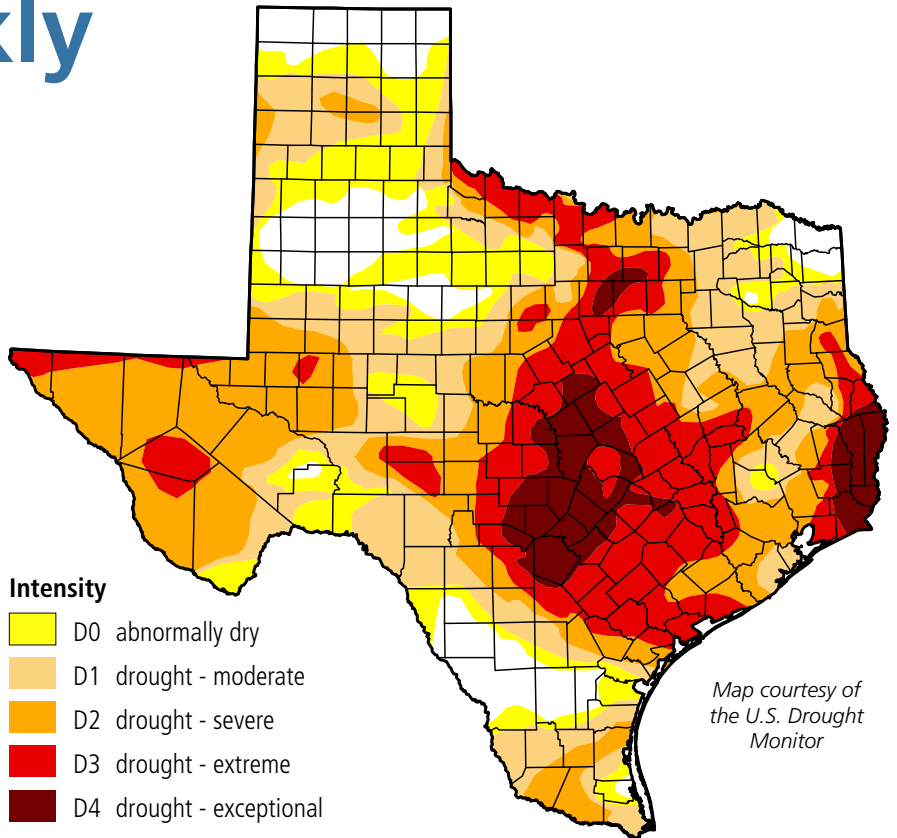


# Water Weekly

## Water conditions

The drought map for conditions as of October 24 shows a small increase in the area of the state impacted by drought. Since October 24, about half the state has received two or more inches of precipitation. Expect drought to contract on next week's map.



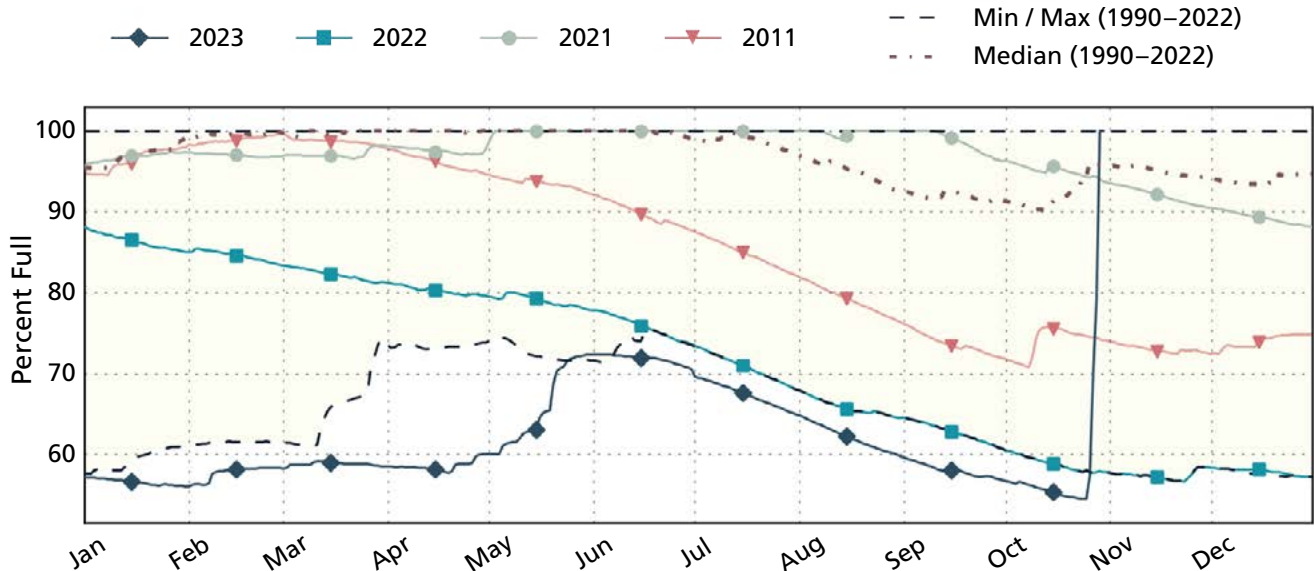
## Drought conditions

## Waco Lake storage

Recent rains have been beneficial for Waco Lake. In the last week, storage climbed from 54.5 percent of capacity on October 25 to 100 percent of conservation storage on October 29. Statewide, water supply reservoirs are at 68 percent of capacity and have plenty of room to store additional runoff.
