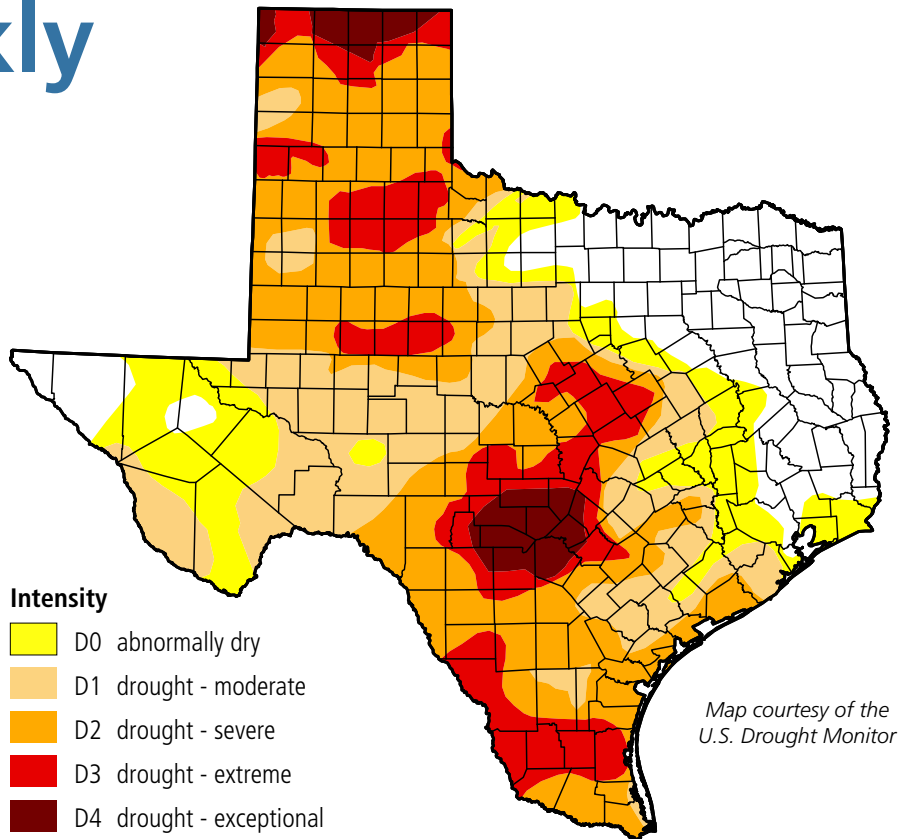

Water conditions

The latest drought monitor map, for conditions as of March 28, shows drought contraction in north central Texas but expansion in the Panhandle and central and coastal Texas. For the sixth week in the last seven weeks, the total area of the state impacted by drought increased.

Drought conditions

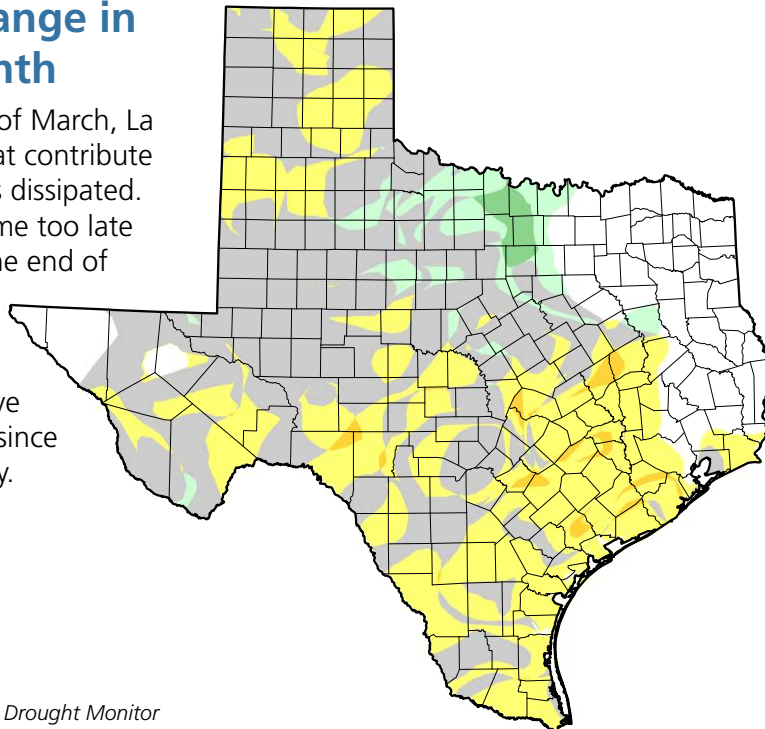
- ◆ 67% now
- ◆ 64% a week ago
- ◆ 49% three months ago
- ◆ 88% a year ago



Drought change in the last month

During the month of March, La Niña conditions that contribute to drought in Texas dissipated. But the change came too late to bring relief by the end of the month.

The area of the state impacted by drought is up five percentage points since the end of February.
