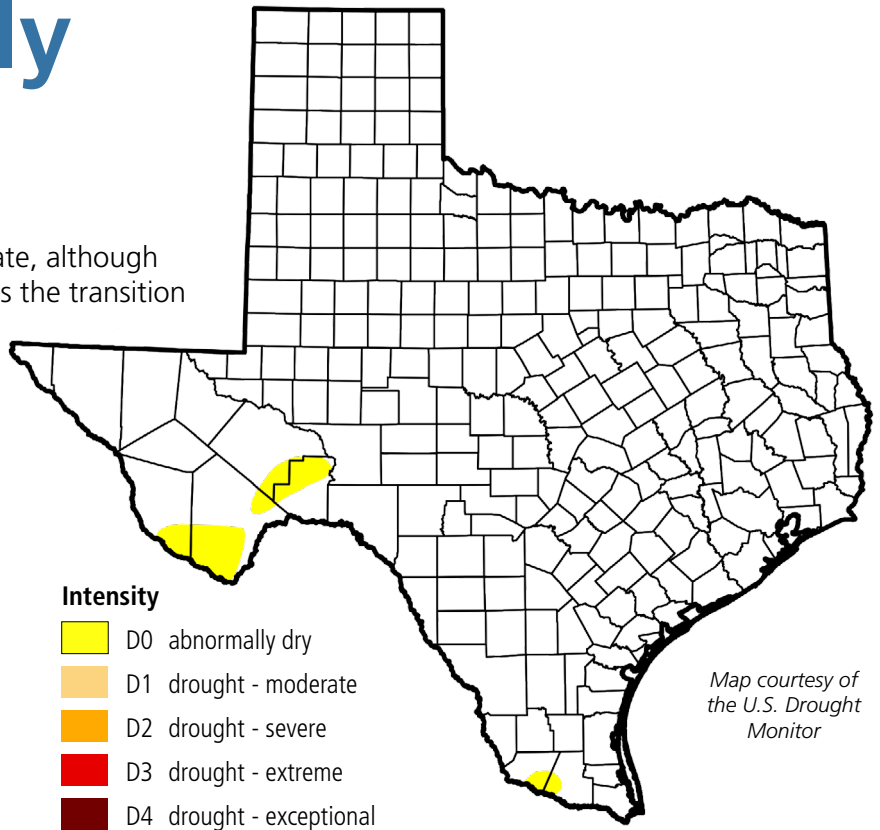

## Water conditions

Not much change in conditions across the state, although the abnormally dry category, which represents the transition to and from drought, increased slightly in south and west Texas. Regional reservoir storage levels have also remained relatively stable for about a month now.

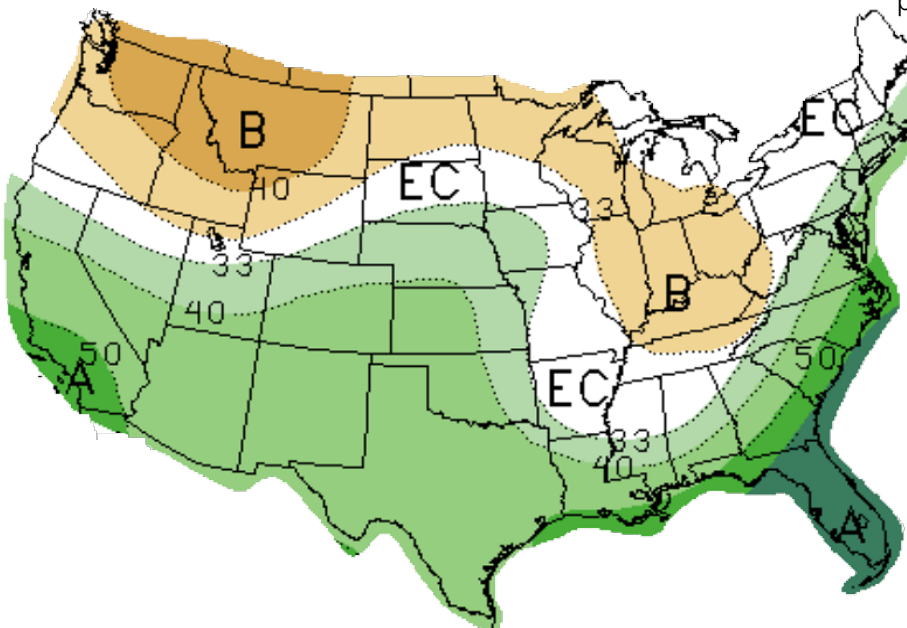
## Drought conditions
