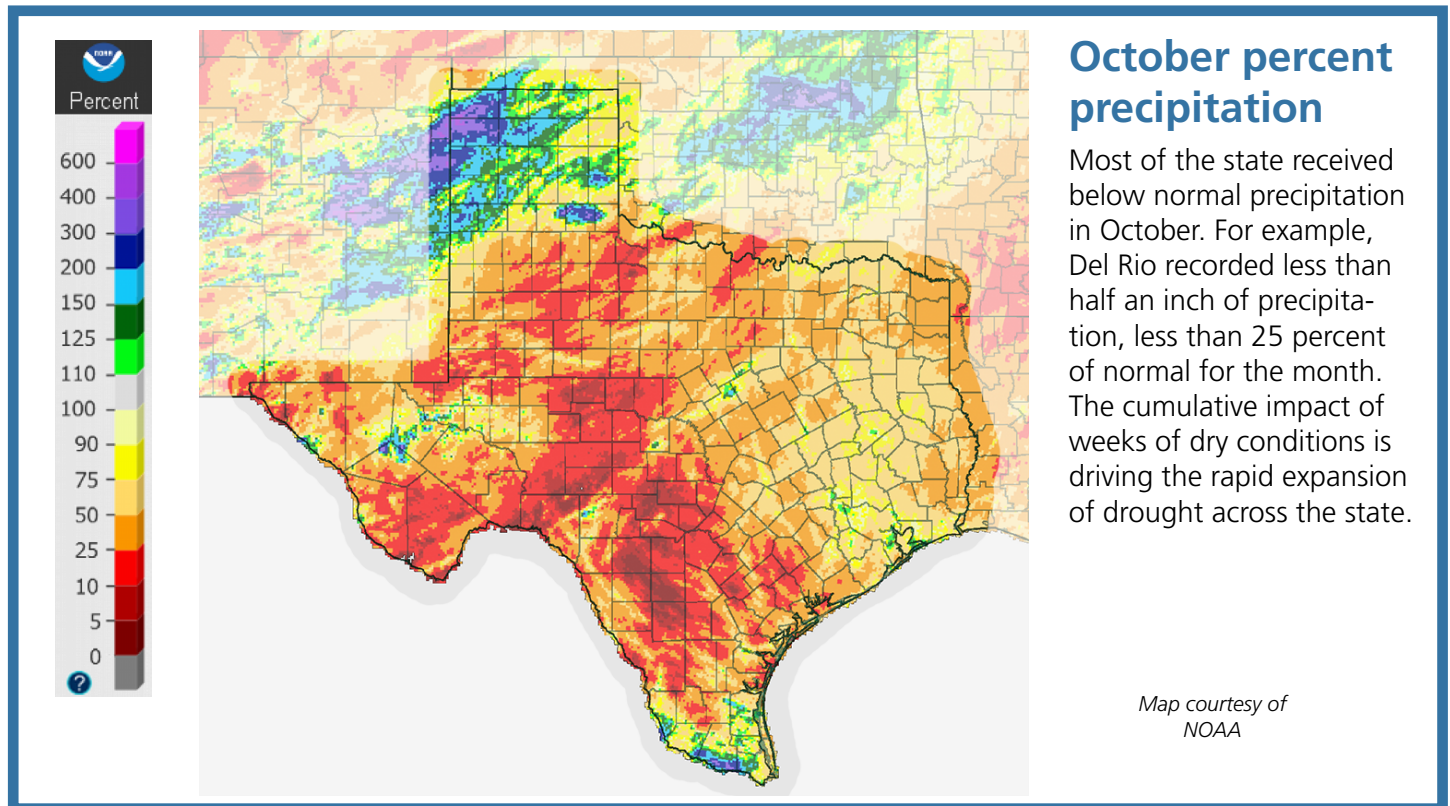
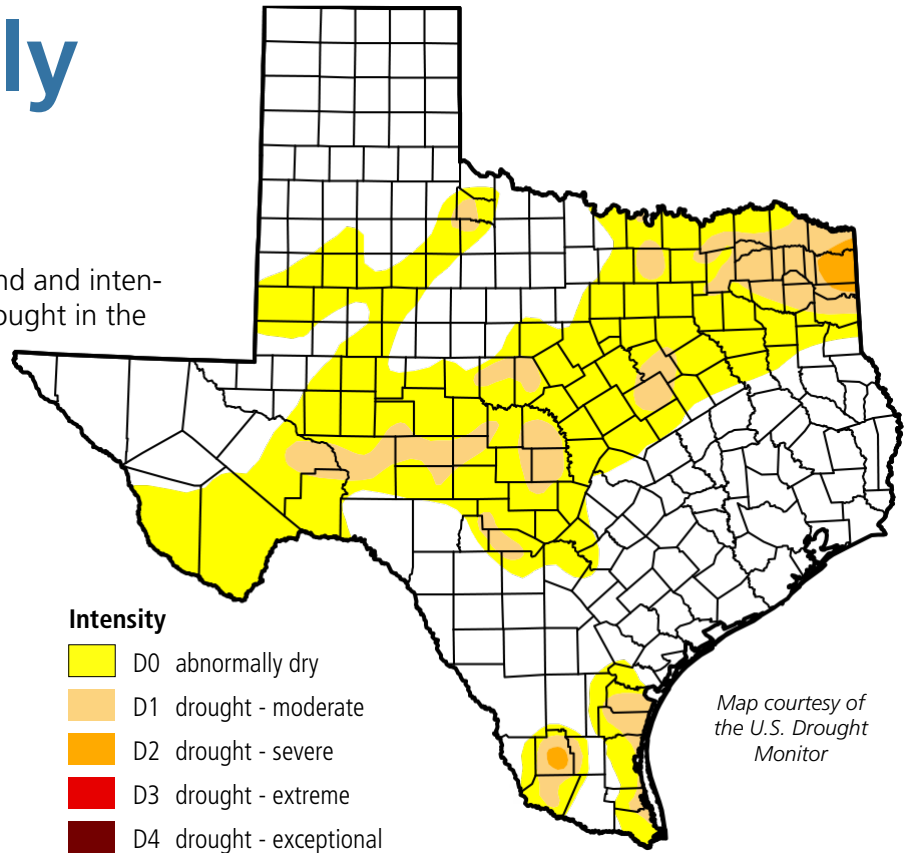

Water conditions

In the last week, drought continued to expand and intensify across the state. Scattered pockets of drought in the south, center, and northeast now cover 9 percent of the state. A third of the state is abnormally dry, in danger of slipping into drought in the next few weeks.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 9% now
- ◆ 3% a week ago
- ◆ 4% three months ago
- ◆ 14% a year ago



October percent precipitation

Most of the state received below normal precipitation in October. For example, Del Rio recorded less than half an inch of precipitation, less than 25 percent of normal for the month. The cumulative impact of weeks of dry conditions is driving the rapid expansion of drought across the state.
