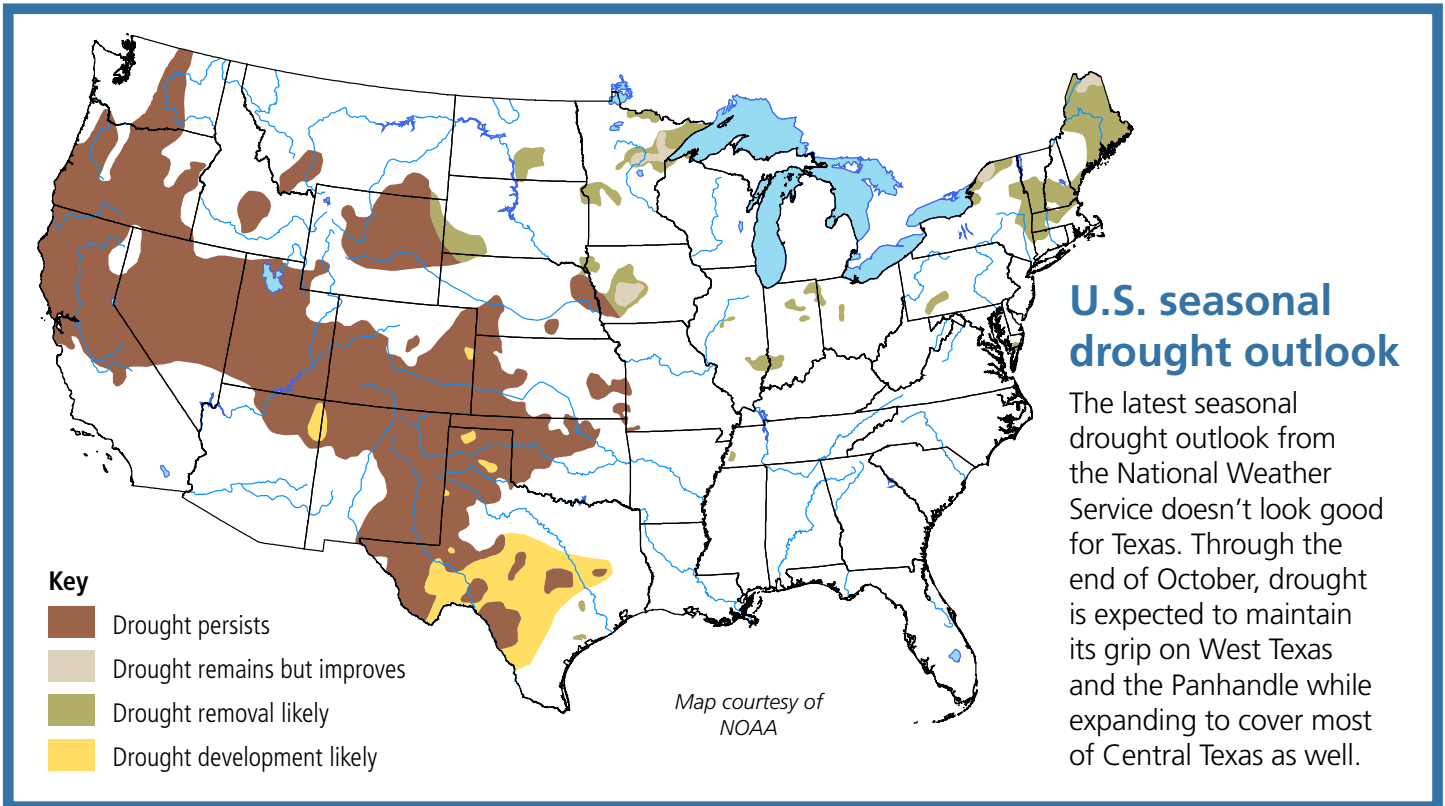
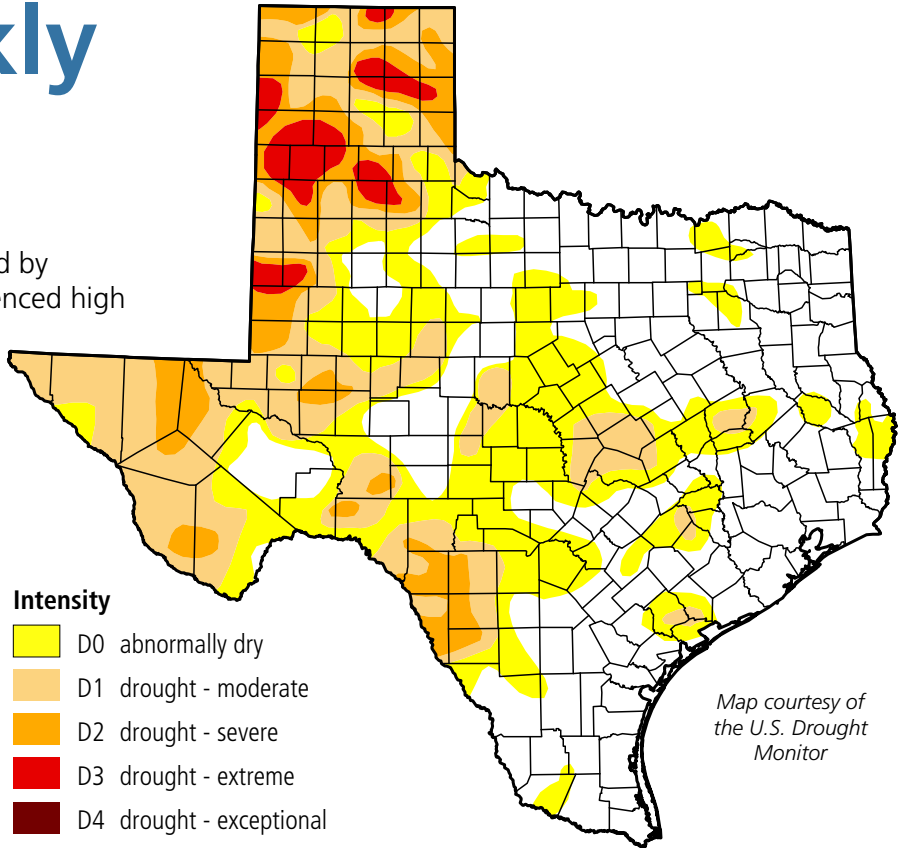

Water conditions

With the exception of a few areas impacted by scattered storms, most of Texas has experienced high temperatures and drier-than-normal conditions during the first half of July. As a result, the latest drought map for conditions as of July 14 shows significant expansion of drought.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 32% now
- ◆ 25% a week ago
- ◆ 16% three months ago
- ◆ 2% a year ago
