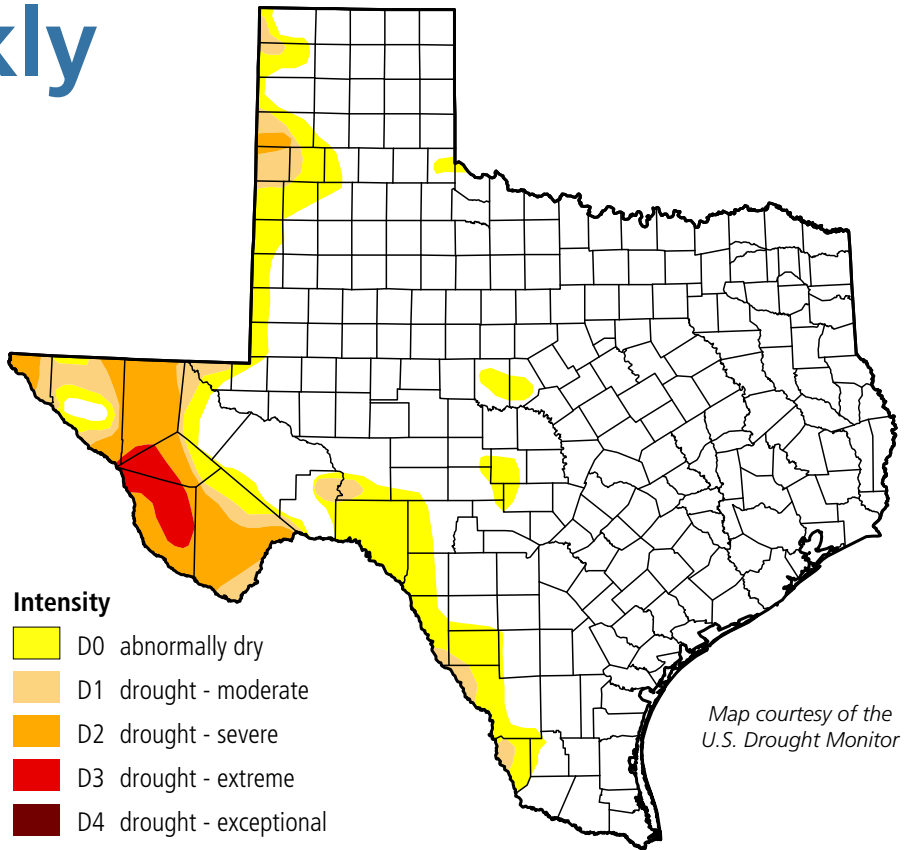

## Water conditions

Recent rainfall in West Texas had a beneficial impact on one of the few areas of drought remaining in the state. As a result, the latest drought map for conditions as of June 29 shows the smallest total area of the state impacted by drought since May 2020.

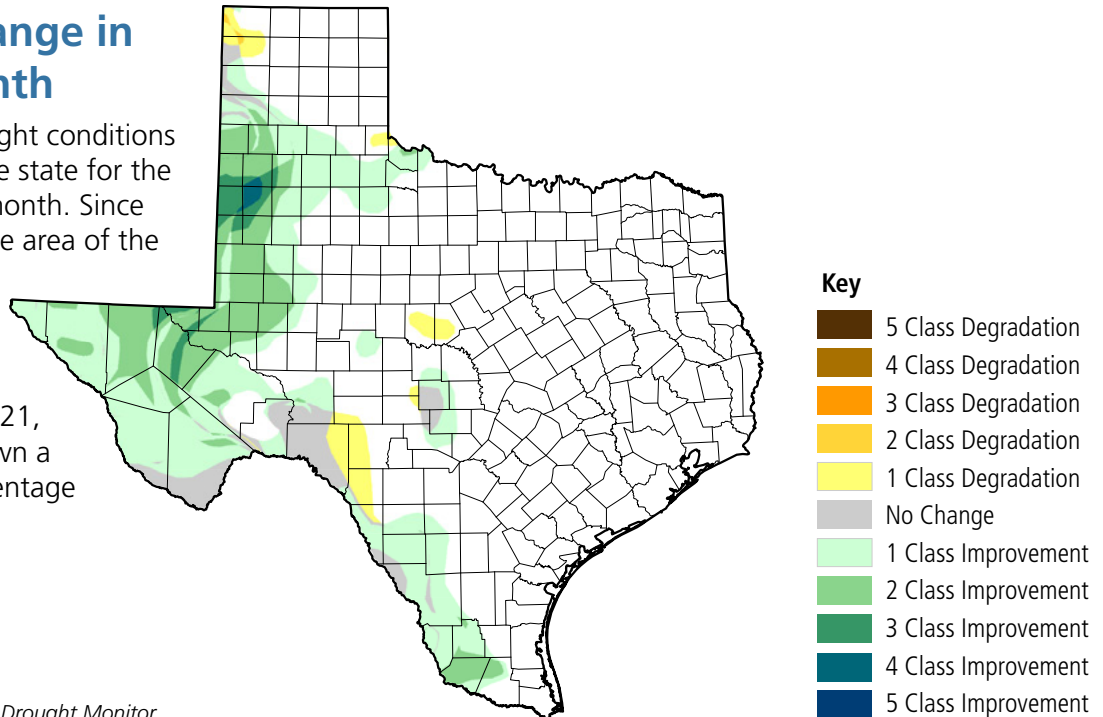
## Drought conditions

- ◆ 9% now
- ◆ 13% a week ago
- ◆ 69% three months ago
- ◆ 28% a year ago



## Drought change in the last month

In June 2021, drought conditions improved across the state for the third consecutive month. Since early June 2021, the area of the state impacted by drought has declined 10 percentage points. Since early April 2021, drought area is down a whopping 65 percentage points.
