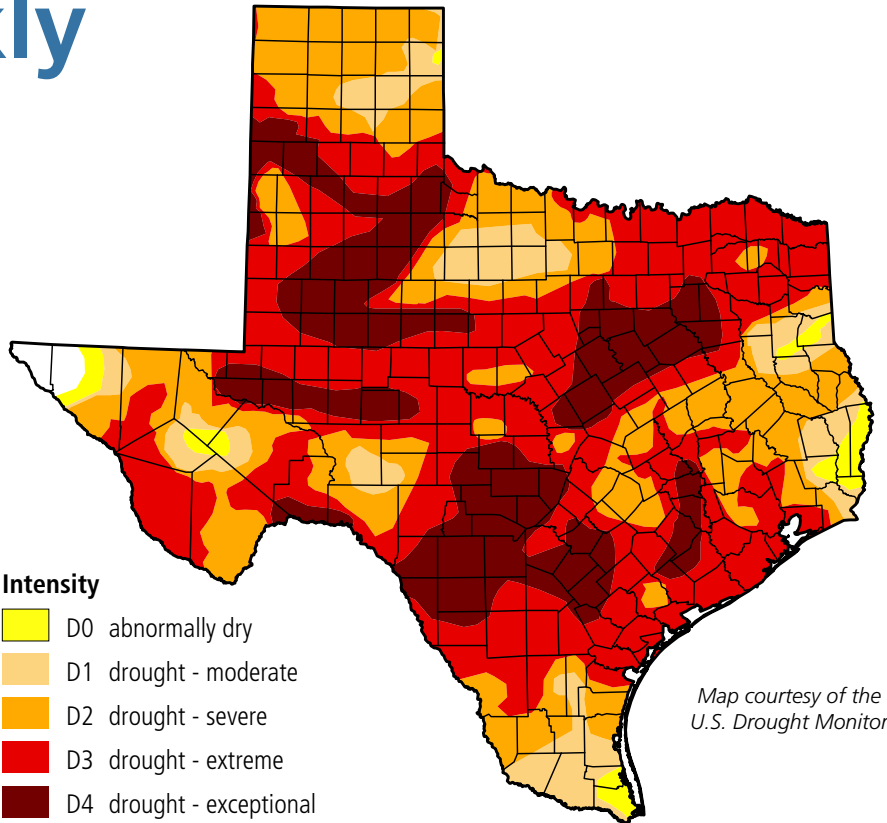

Water conditions

The drought map for August 2 conditions shows improvement in parts of West Texas and the Panhandle but degradation in other areas. The total area of drought was unchanged from last week, but extreme or worse drought was up two percentage points and now covers 62 percent of the state.

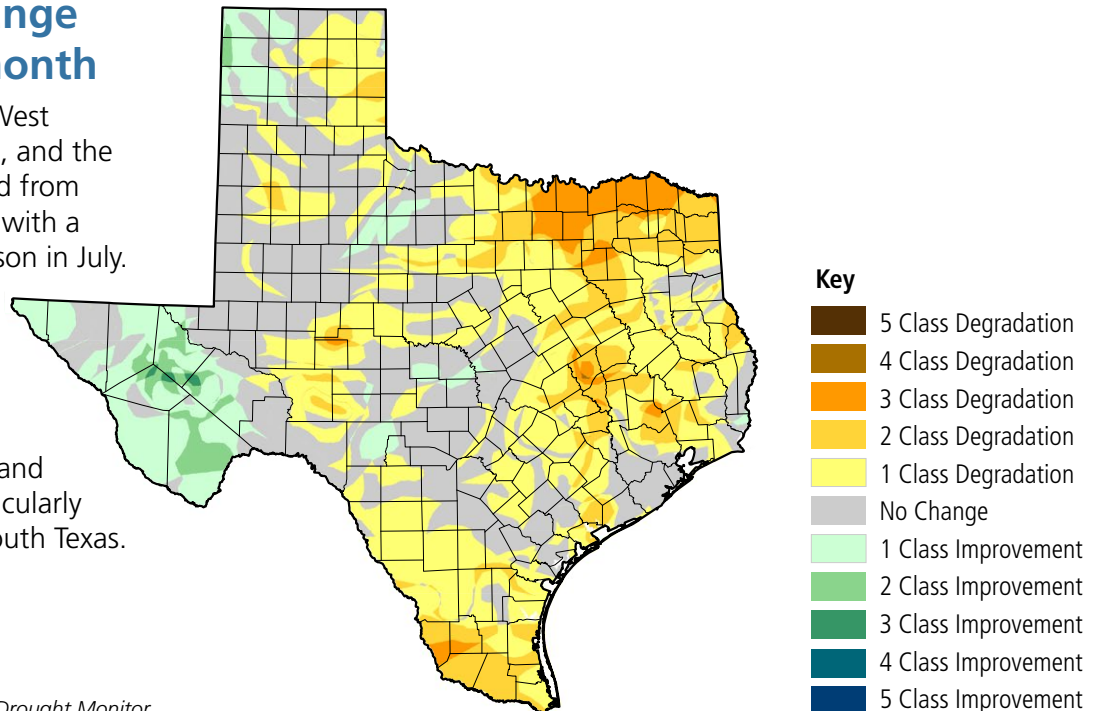


Drought conditions

Drought change in the last month

Scattered areas of West Texas, Central Texas, and the Panhandle benefited from showers associated with a good monsoon season in July. But precipitation was below average in large areas of the rest of the state, driving drought expansion and intensification, particularly in East Texas and South Texas.
