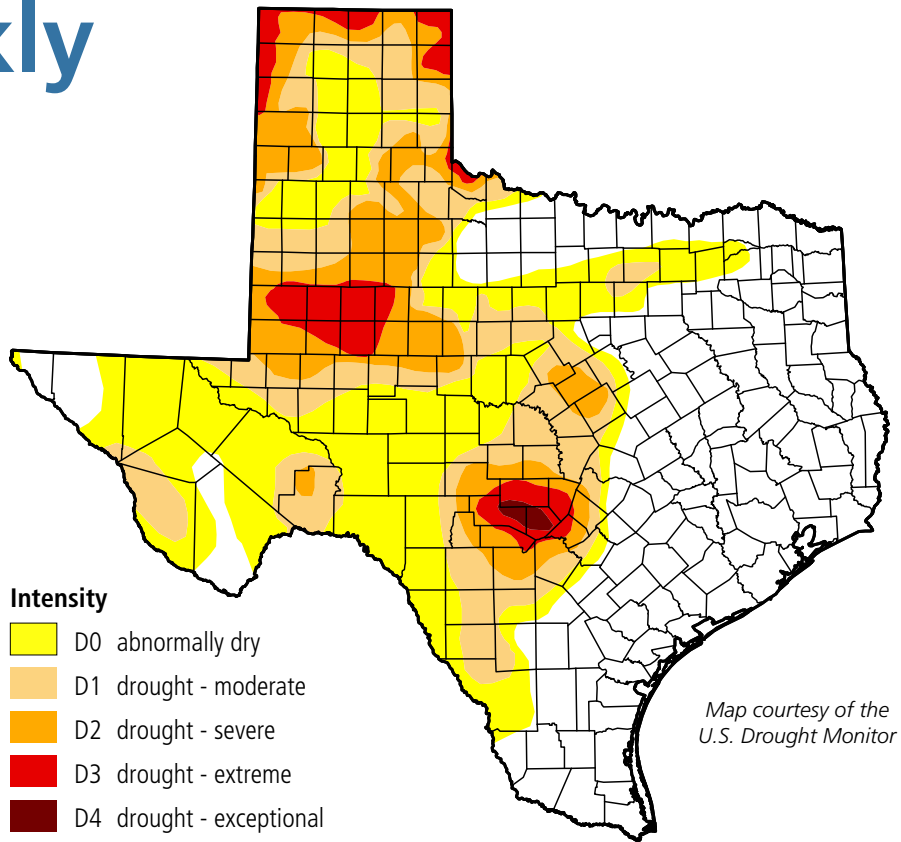

Water conditions

The latest drought map, for conditions as of May 30, shows the ninth consecutive weekly decrease in the area of the state impacted by drought. Exceptional drought now impacts less than half of one percent of the state, its smallest extent since March 2022.

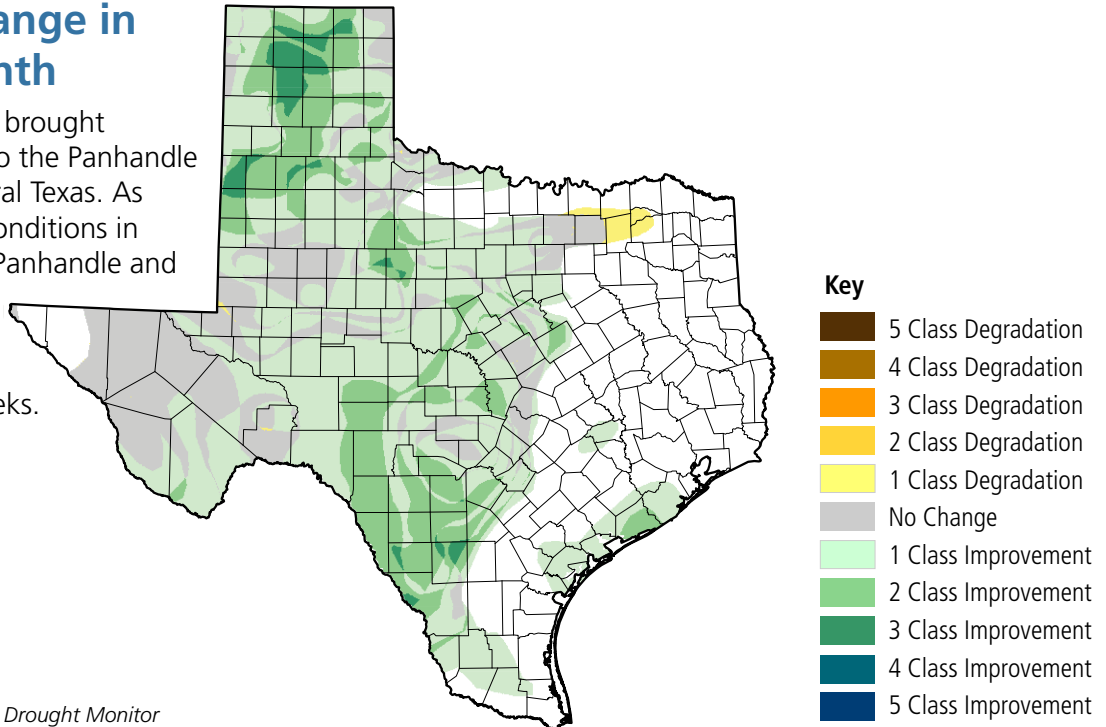
Drought conditions

- ◆ 34% now
- ◆ 42% a week ago
- ◆ 62% three months ago
- ◆ 78% a year ago



Drought change in the last month

The month of May brought abundant rainfall to the Panhandle and much of Central Texas. As a result, drought conditions in some parts of the Panhandle and Central Texas improved three drought categories in the last four weeks.
