

Stephenville accumulated precipitation

From August 13 to October 23 of this year, Stephenville (in Erath County, southwest of Fort Worth) went 72 days without measurable precipitation, the second longest such streak on record. From November 4, 1950, to January 28, 1951, Stephenville went 86 days without measurable precipitation.
