

DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Drought conditions slightly worsened in the state in the Panhandle and south Texas, but we're up 50,000 acre-feet (0.1 percentage points) in water storage in the reservoirs we monitor. The most recent seasonal drought outlook map through the end of April suggests further development of drought conditions in the Panhandle and far west Texas and development of drought in the northern Gulf Coast area.

Current drought statistics


- 45% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 44% a week ago
- 65% three months ago
- 74% a year ago



STATEWIDE RESERVOIR STORAGE LEVELS

Monitored water supply reservoirs

- Currently 64% full
- 64% a week ago
- 60% three months ago
- 67% a year ago
- Normally 80% full this time of year
