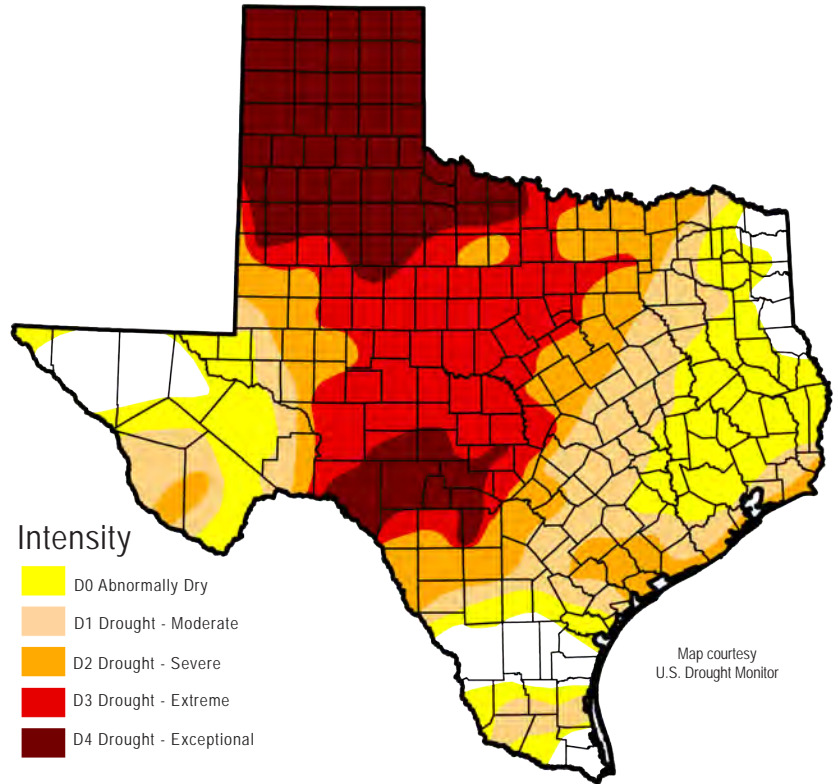


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

After several weeks of bad news, it's good to have a week of promising news. Thanks to recent rains, we saw decreases in drought levels across the board. Additionally, the odds of having an El Nino this year increased to 65 percent. Nevertheless, nearly 75 percent of the state remains in drought as we enter the summer months.

Drought statistics

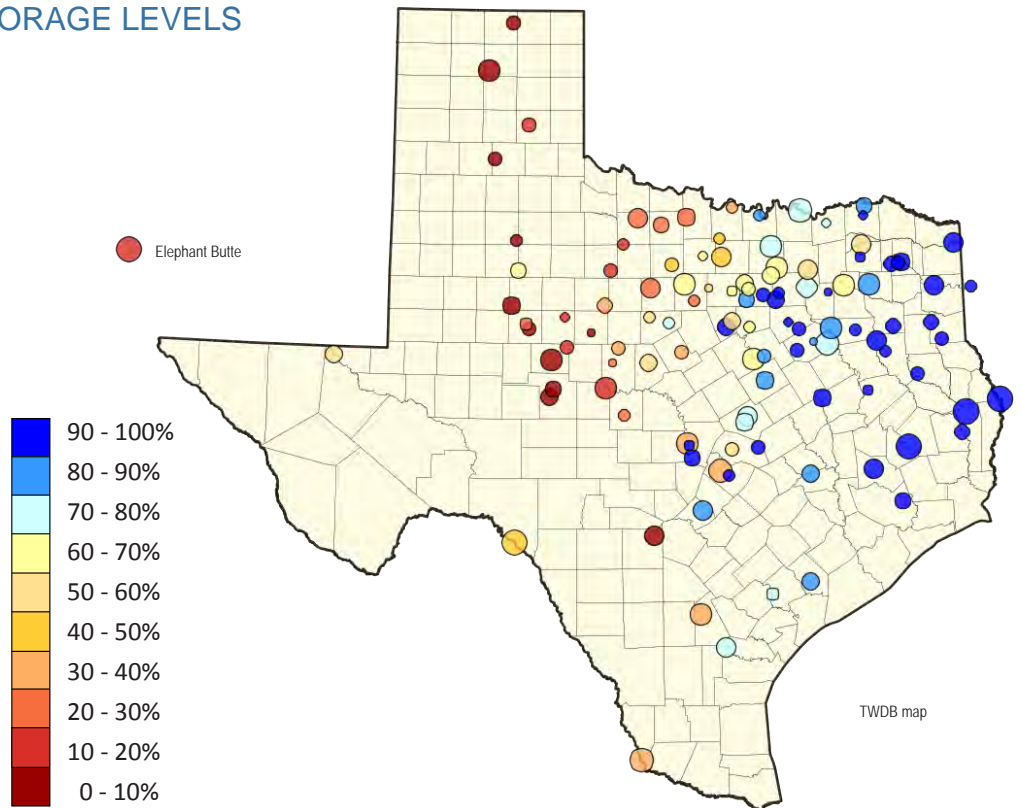
- 73% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 83% a week ago
- 54% three months ago
- 91% a year ago



STATEWIDE RESERVOIR STORAGE LEVELS

Monitored water supply reservoirs

- Currently 66% full
- 65% a week ago
- 64% three months ago
- 66% a year ago
- Normally 86% at this time
