

DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Although the gorgeous weather this past week invited jealousy from our northern friends and family, it wasn't a great week for drought relief. Exceptional drought, the worst category, reappeared in Central Texas and strengthened its hold on North Texas. Statewide reservoir volumes held steady.


Drought statistics

- 39% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 39% a week ago
- · 44% three months ago
- 54% a year ago



RESERVOIR LEVELS

Statewide reservoir levels have remained remarkably flat over the past year. Under normal conditions, we'd expect storage volumes of 24 to 26 million acre-feet depending on the time of year.
