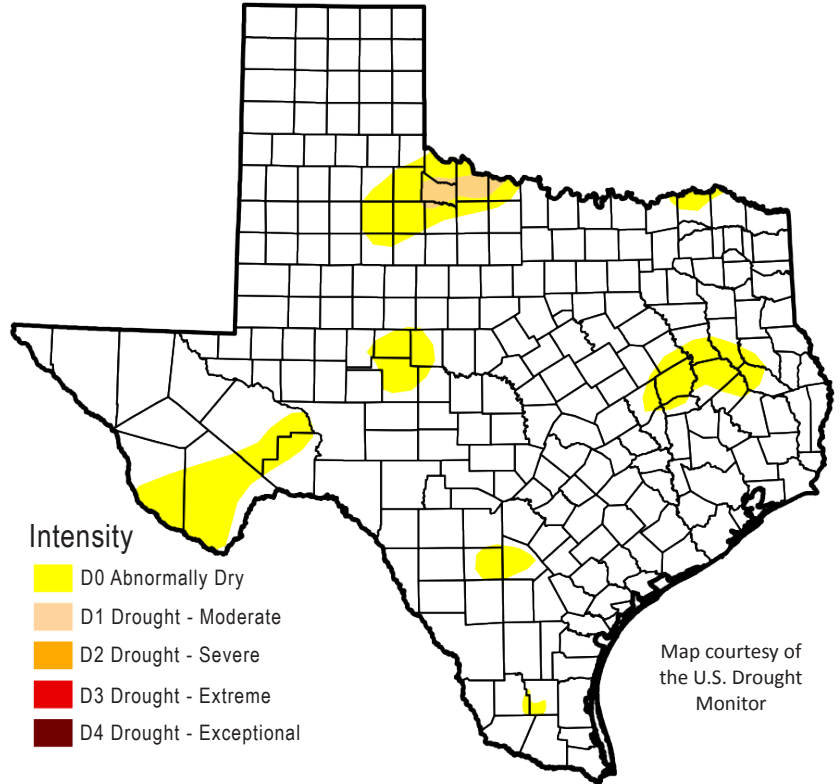


**WATER CONDITIONS**

Drought retreated even more this past week, with only the Wichita Falls area showing moderate drought for a statewide drought total of less than 1 percent. Current statewide reservoir storage is 3.5 percentage points above normal for this time of year and 20 percentage points higher than a year ago.

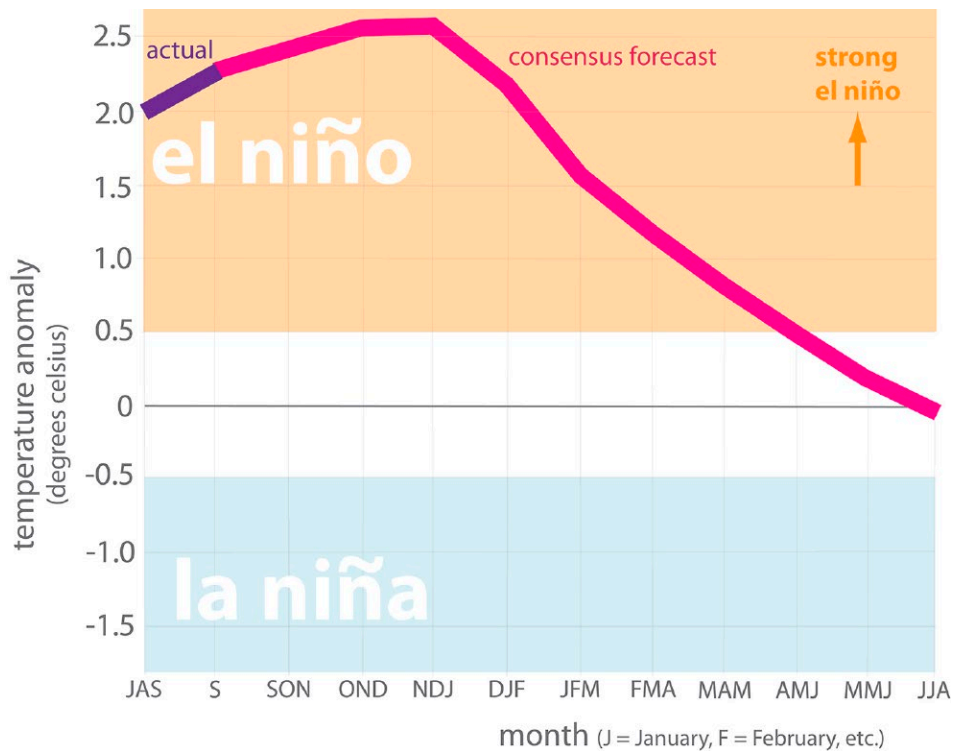
**Drought conditions**

- 0.6% now
- 4.3% a week ago
- 18% three months ago
- 44% a year ago
