
Water conditions


Easy come, easy go (and thankfully so)! Recent rains completely rubbed out drought conditions in Central Texas;

however, moderate drought increased in the Lower Rio Grande Valley and Corpus Christi areas. Overall statewide drought conditions decreased from 3.6 to 0.8 percent of the state. More rain is expected over the next week in the northwestern part of the state.
