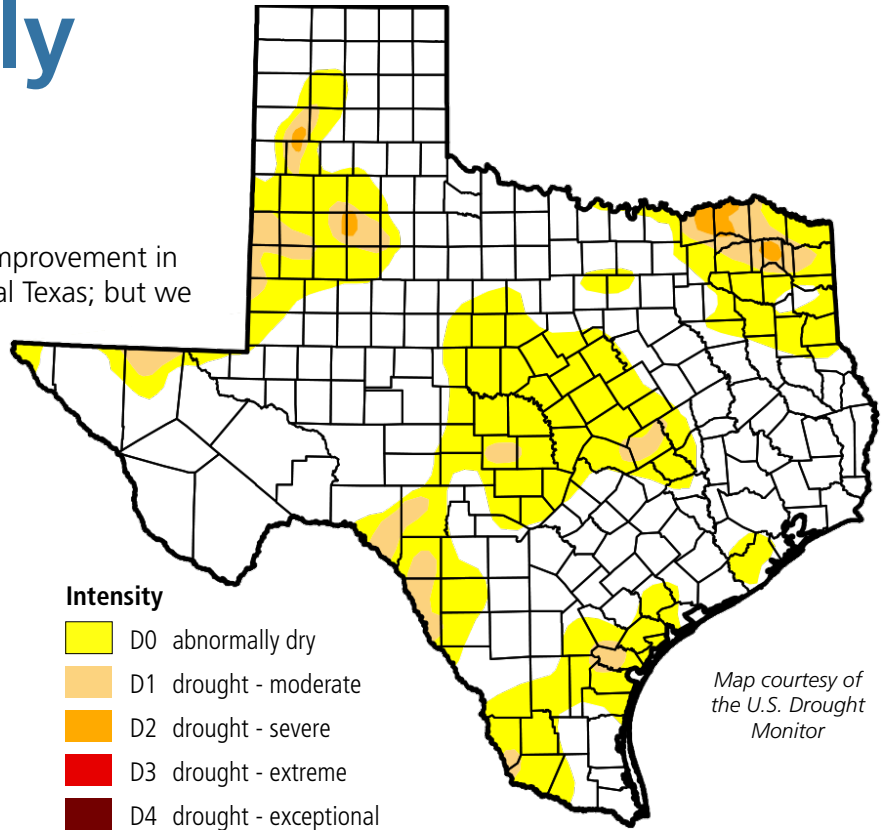

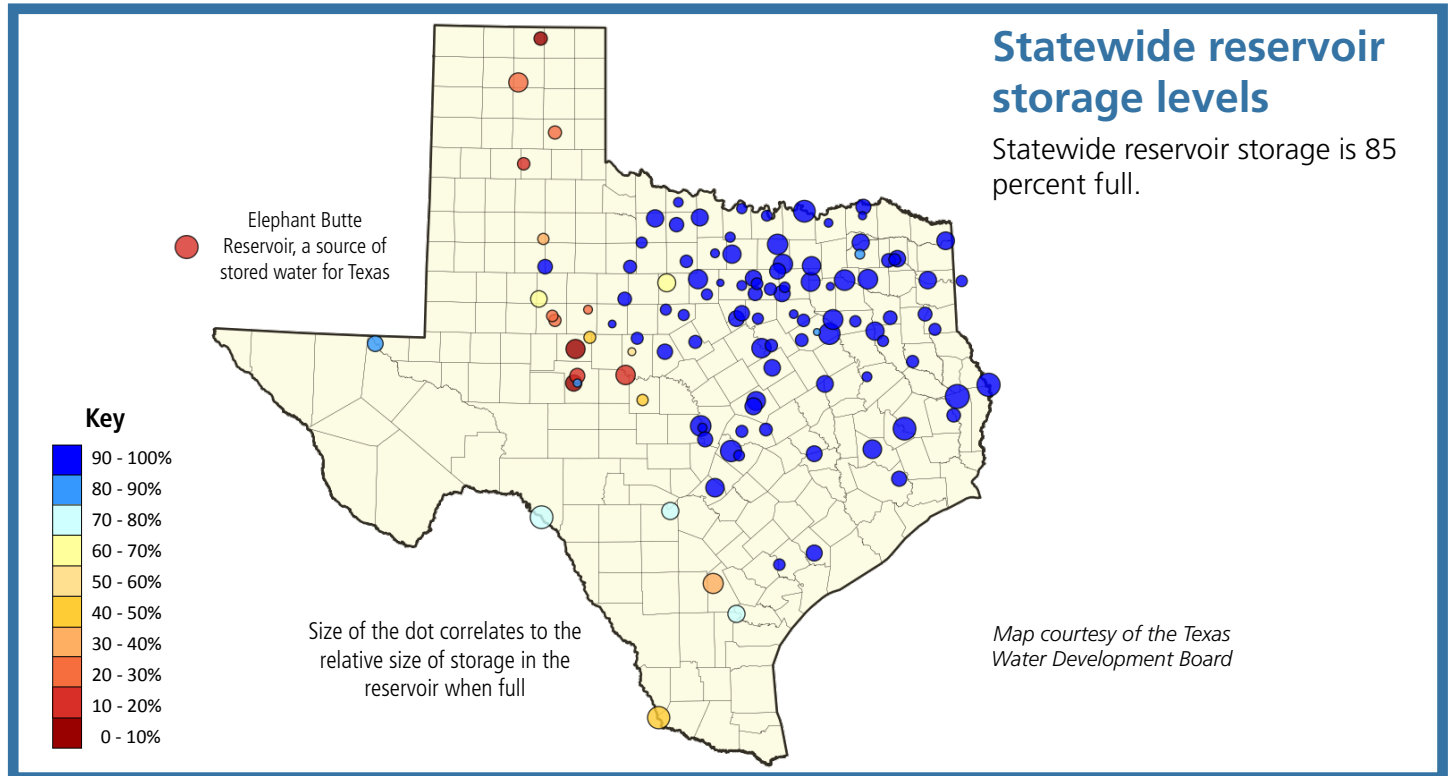
Water conditions

Last week was a mixed bag: We saw some improvement in drought conditions, especially in south central Texas; but we also saw degradation scattered throughout the state. Statewide reservoir conditions are above normal for this time of year by 4 percent, although levels in western reservoirs remain below normal.



Drought conditions

- ◆ 6% now
- ◆ 6% a week ago
- ◆ 1% three months ago
- ◆ 5% a year ago



Statewide reservoir storage levels

Statewide reservoir storage is 85 percent full.
