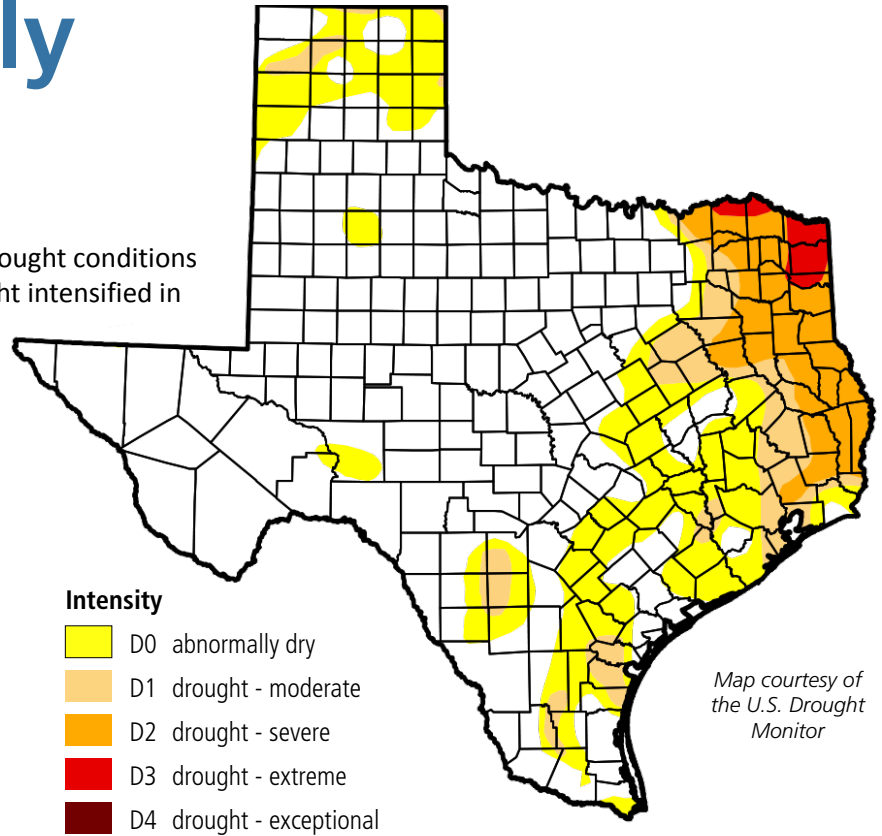

Water conditions

Thanksgiving week brought improvement to drought conditions along the southern Gulf Coast; however, drought intensified in northeast Texas with extreme drought in Bowie, Cass, and Marion counties. Although the landscape is suffering severe and extreme drought, reservoir levels in the East Texas climate region remain above normal at 89 percent full.

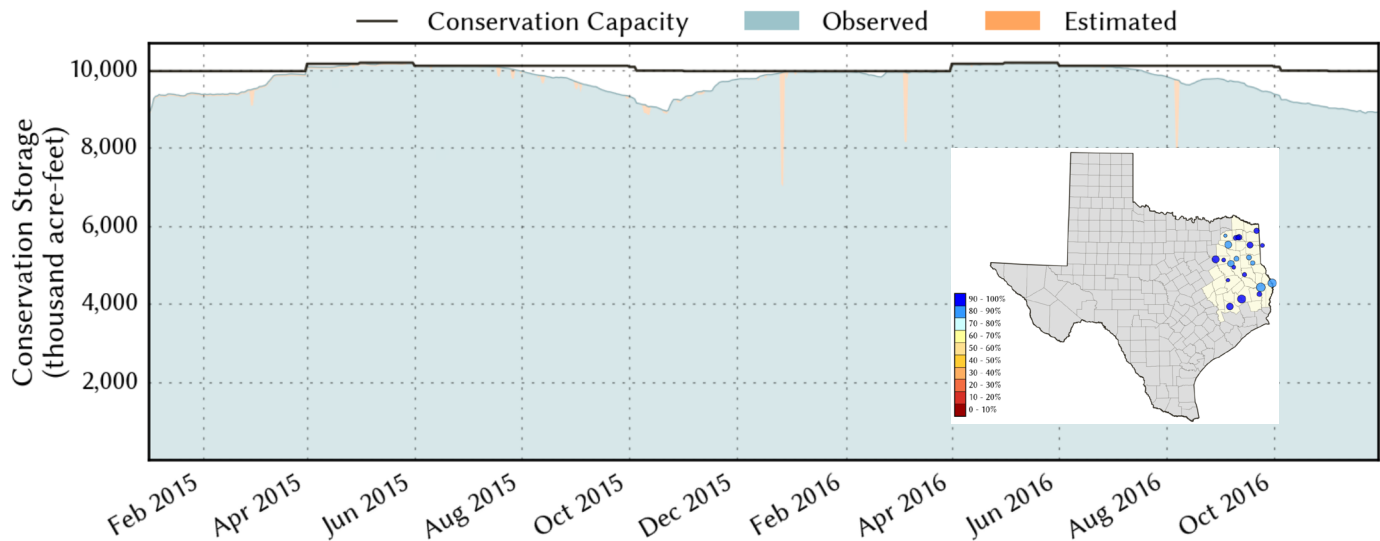
Drought conditions

- ◆ 15% now
- ◆ 16% a week ago
- ◆ 4% three months ago
- ◆ 0.6% a year ago



Reservoir levels

Despite the drought in northeast Texas, reservoir levels remain just above normal at 89 percent full with individual reservoirs in the area ranging from 82 to 100 percent full.
