
## **Water conditions**


With much of the eastern half of the state receiving half an inch or more of rain over the past week, drought continued

its retreat; however, a new blob of abnormally dry conditions developed from Wichita Falls to Abilene. Statewide reservoir conditions continue to remain above normal for this time of year.
