


Water conditions

Rains that traveled through the center of the state resulted in major improvements in statewide drought conditions. Where drought remains—in the lower Rio Grande Valley and north-east Texas—moderate drought conditions expanded slightly. Thankfully, Nate missed Texas; however, hurricane season extends to the end of November with the peak season extending to the end of this month.
