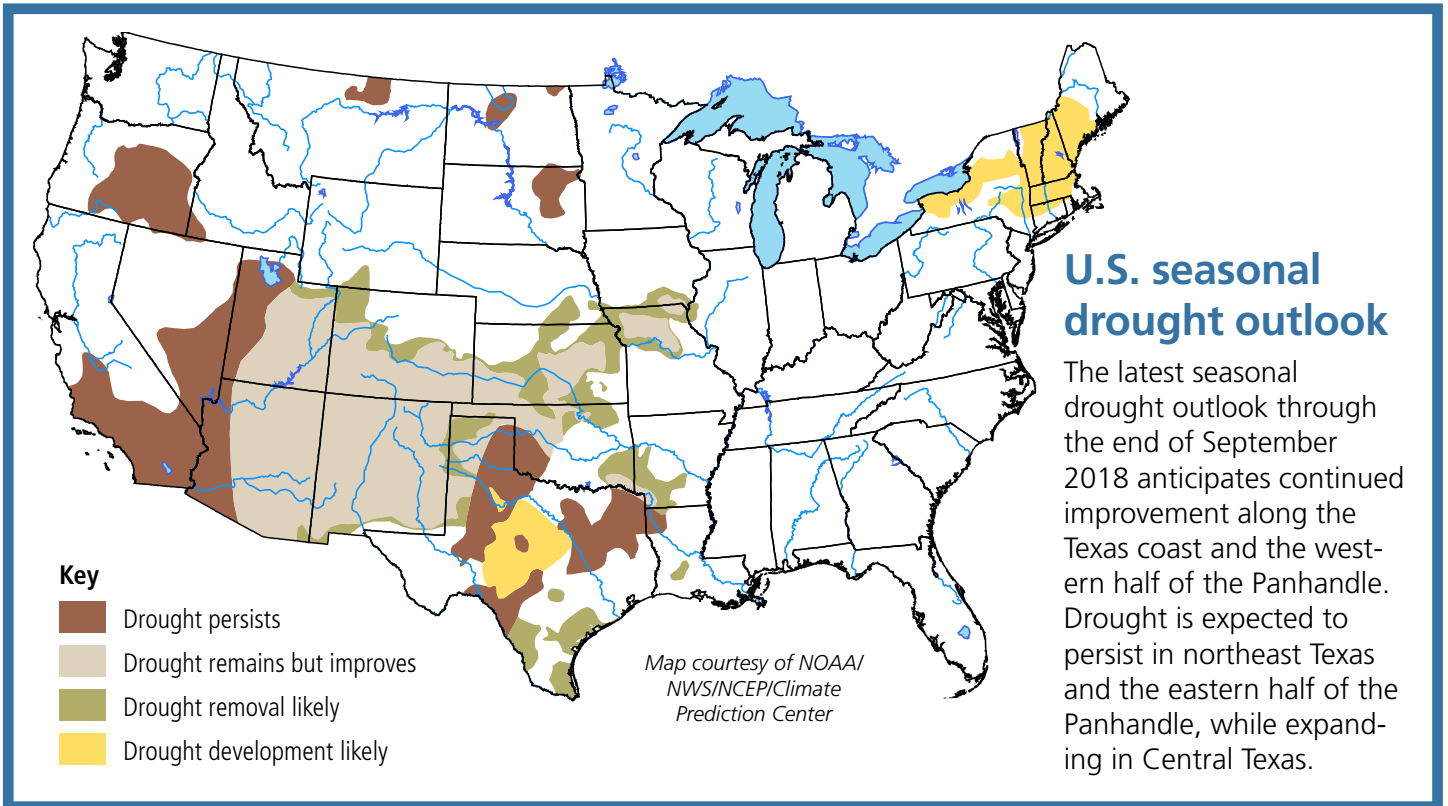
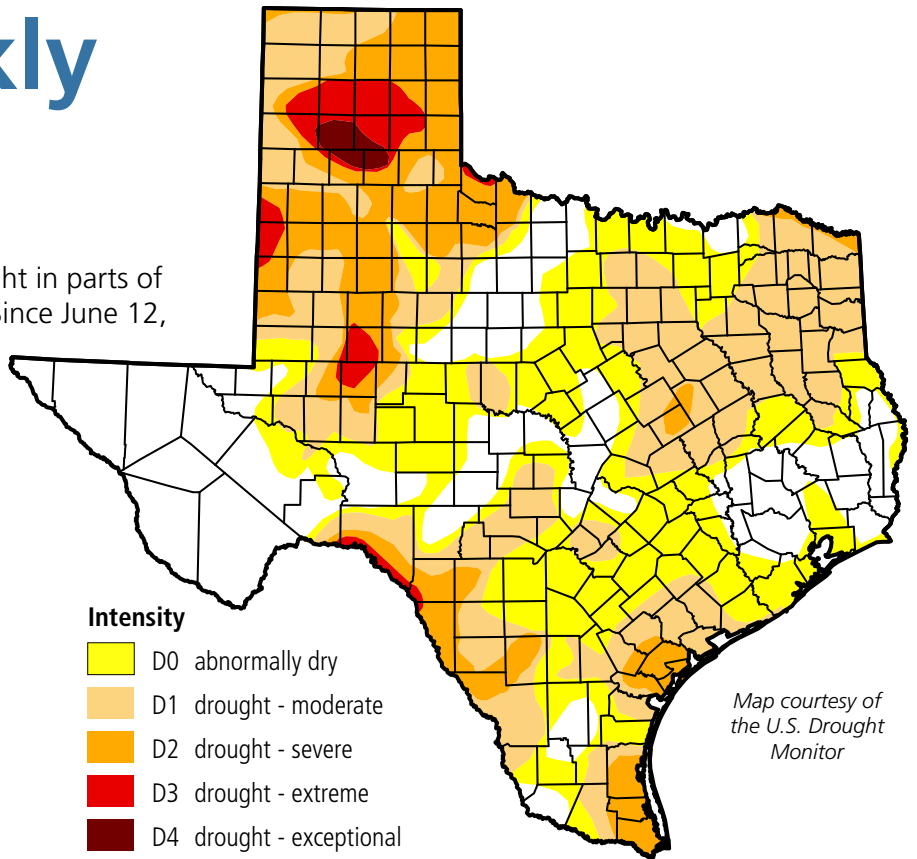

Water conditions

Recent rains reduced the intensity of drought in parts of the Panhandle and along the Texas coast. Since June 12, Amarillo has received 2 inches of rainfall, more than in the previous 6 months. Large areas of the coast have received 5 or more inches of precipitation.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 47% now
- ◆ 50% a week ago
- ◆ 61% three months ago
- ◆ 5% a year ago
