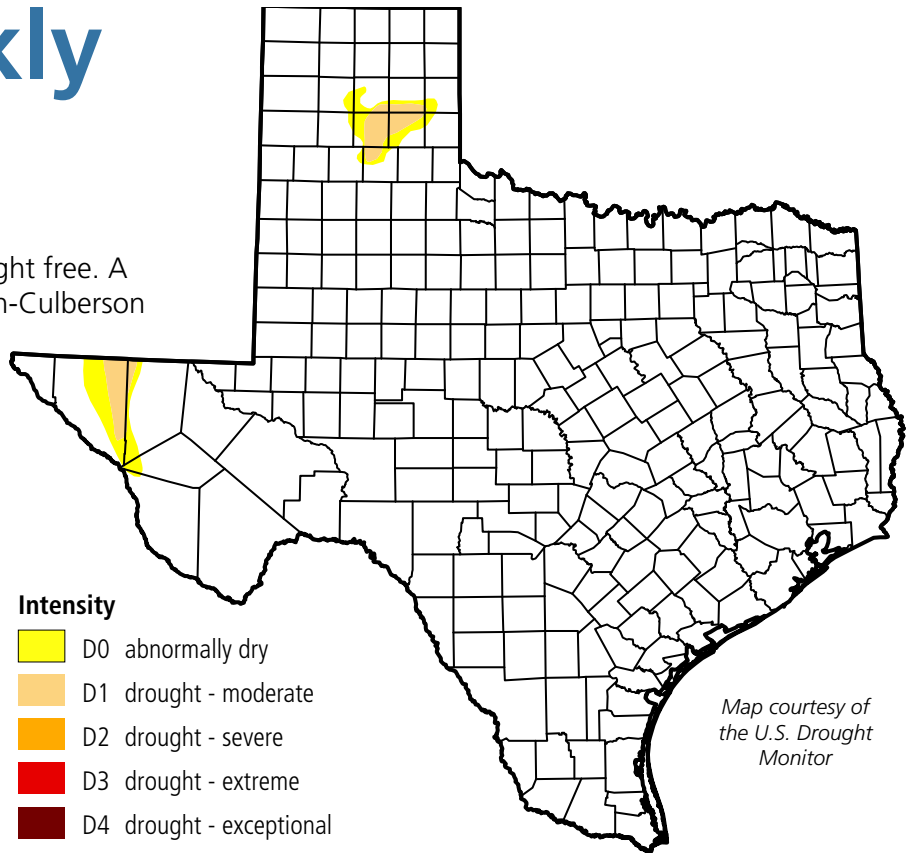

## Water conditions

All but two areas of the state remain drought free. A small pocket of drought near the Hudspeth-Culberson county line in far West Texas has persisted for 19 weeks. Another, centered on Armstrong County in the Panhandle, has persisted for 47 weeks.

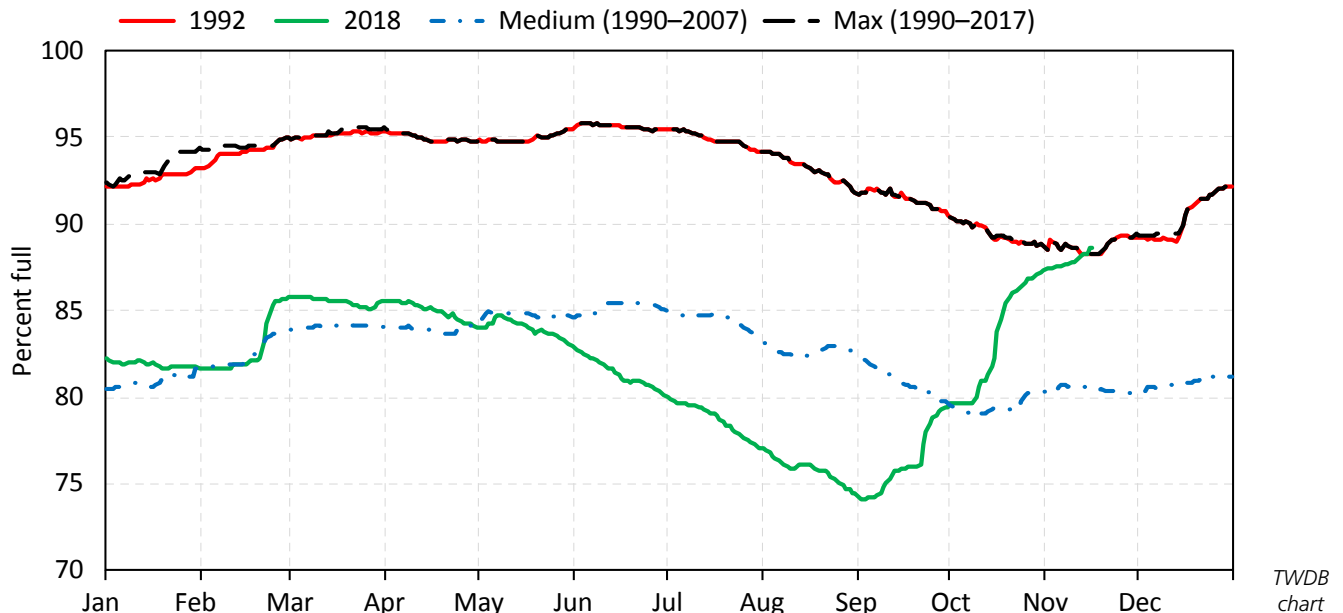
## Drought conditions

## Statewide reservoir storage

Since early September 2018, statewide water supply storage is up more than 14 percentage points. Storage is currently 88.6 percent of capacity, slightly surpassing the mid-November capacity record set in 1992.
