



U.S. seasonal drought outlook

The National Weather Service expects drought to persist and expand in Central Texas through the end of December. Drought is expected to be removed from most of East Texas where Tropical Depression Imelda dropped excessive rainfall more than 20 inches in some areas—in the last week.
