


Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of November 26 shows little change from the previous week. Small improvements in Central Texas were offset by the reemergence of drought in the Panhandle. Overall, moderate or worse drought conditions continue to impact 32 percent of the state.

Drought conditions

- ♦ 32% now
- ♦ 32% a week ago
- ♦ 38% three months ago
- ♦ 0.8% a year ago





November precipitation

November 2019 brought well below average precipitation to central and east Texas. For example, the area around Tyler historically averages more than 4 inches of precipitation in November but received less than 1 inch this year.
