


Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of March 3 shows drought intensification in South Texas. Extreme drought now covers 6 percent of the state, up from 3 percent last week.

Drought conditions

- ♦ 20% a year ago





February precipitation

January 2020 brought aboveaverage precipitation to large areas of North Texas but below-average precipitation in much of South Texas. Tyler received 8.5 inches, well above its average February rainfall of 3.83 inches. Laredo received 0.2 inches, well below its average of 0.95 inches.
