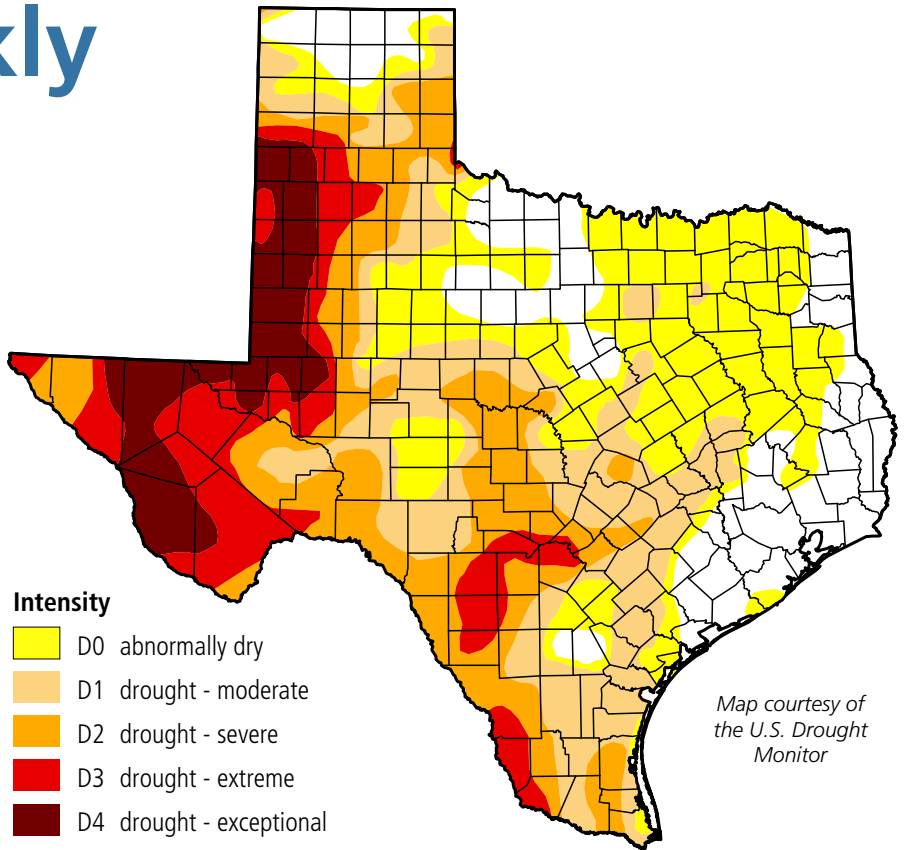

## Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of January 5 shows the largest one-week improvement since September 2018. With additional rain and sometimes snow for parts of the state since January 5, we can expect additional improvements on next week's map.

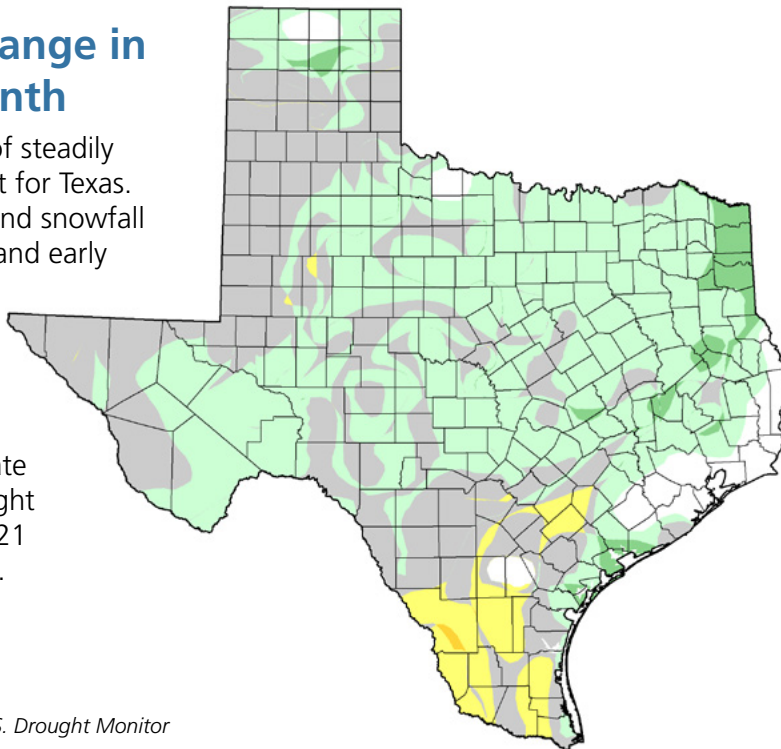
## Drought conditions

- ◆ 58% now
- ◆ 81% a week ago
- ◆ 33% three months ago
- ◆ 38% a year ago



## Drought change in the last month

2020 was a year of steadily increasing drought for Texas. Widespread rain and snowfall in late December and early January have 2021 beginning on a much more encouraging note. In the last month, the area of the state impacted by drought has decreased by 21 percentage points.
