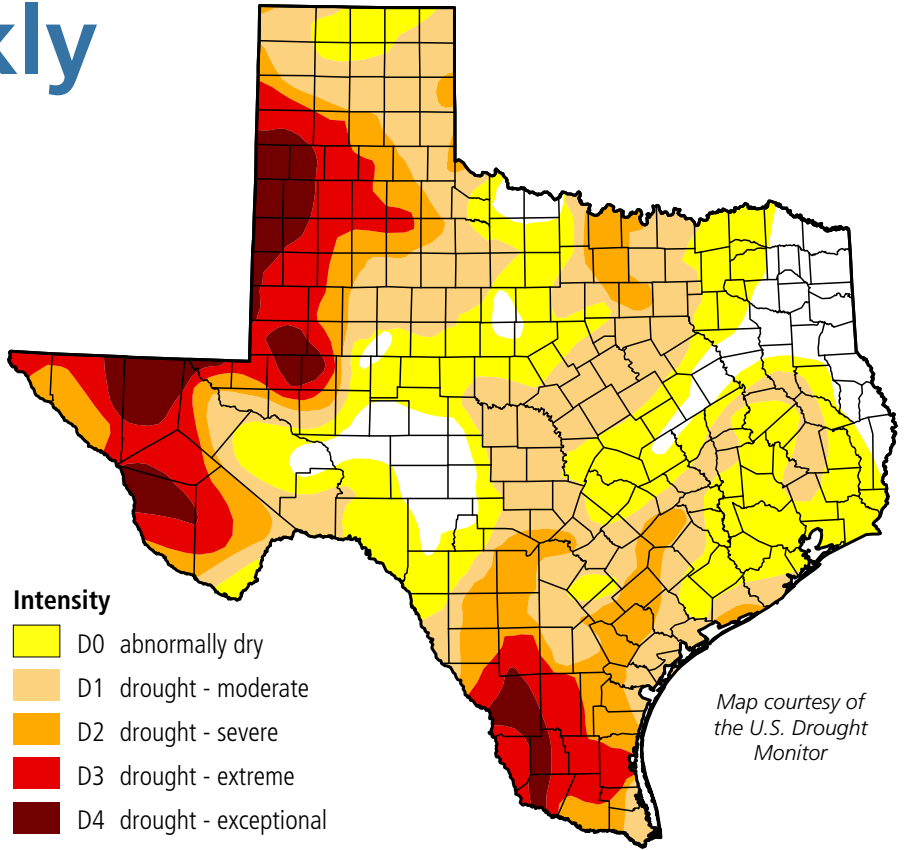

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of March 9 shows expansion of drought for the third consecutive week. Since mid-February, the area of the state impacted by drought has grown by 17 percentage points. Drought now covers more of the state than at any time since late December 2020.

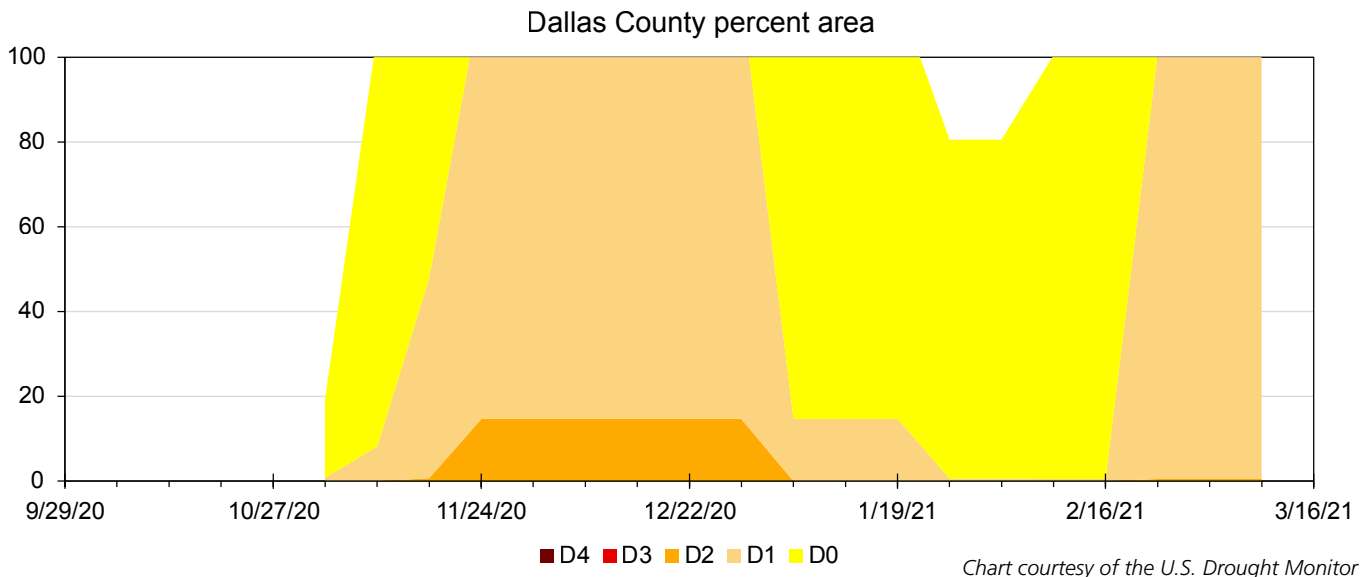


Drought conditions

- ◆ 62% now
- ◆ 54% a week ago
- ◆ 79% three months ago
- ◆ 21% a year ago

Dallas County percent area

Since mid-October, drought has advanced and receded across Dallas County and other parts of north central Texas. The county was covered by drought by mid-November, drought free by late January, and is now back in drought. Since the beginning of October, rainfall has been less than 70 percent of normal.
