



## Elephant Butte Reservoir inflow

Elephant Butte Reservoir, which supplies water to New Mexico and Texas, has a conservation capacity of nearly 2 million acre-feet. Annual inflows have been less than half a million acrefeet for eight of the last 10 years. For the first half of 2021, inflow is less than 200,000 acre-feet.
