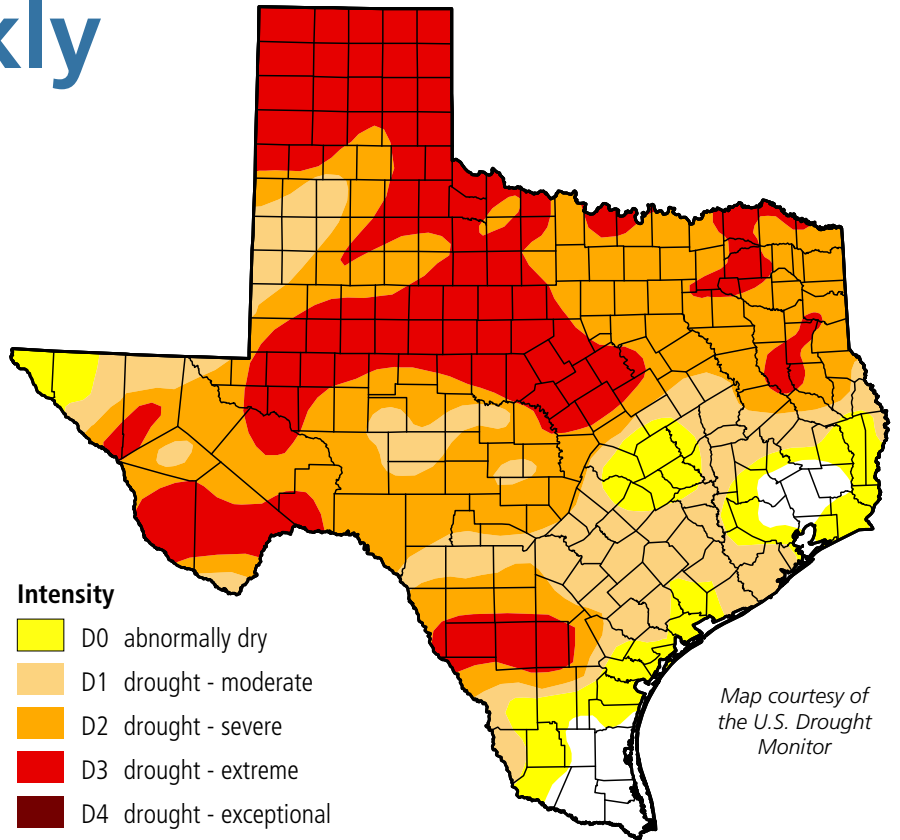

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of January 25 shows an increase in the areas of the state impacted by drought, which is the 11th consecutive week that drought has increased. Scattered rainfall, primarily in Central Texas, since the drought map was published may improve conditions by the next report.



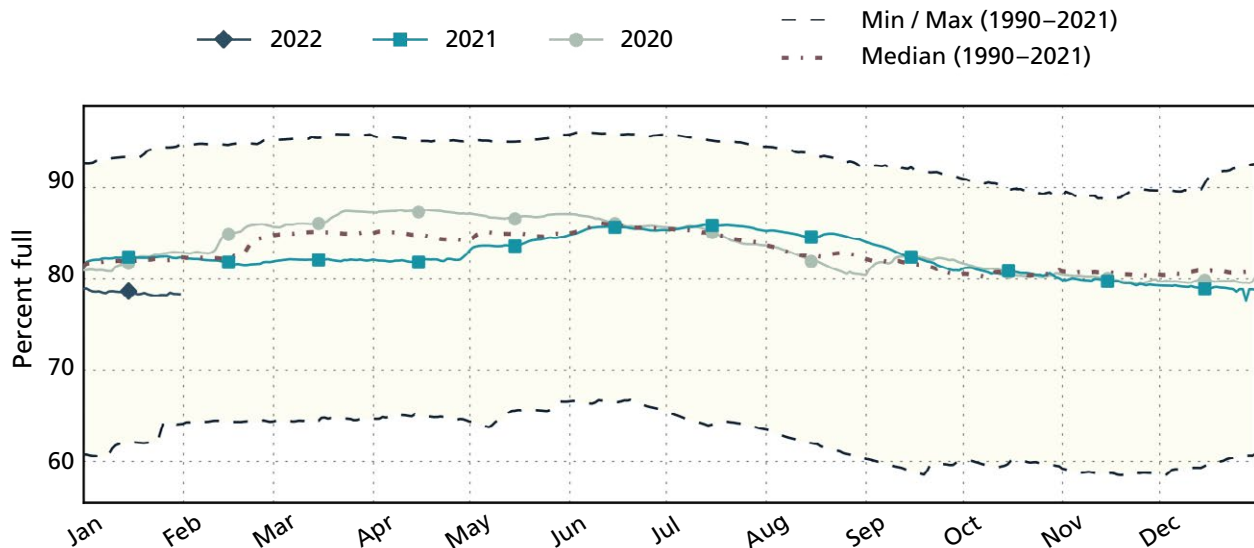
Drought conditions

- ◆ 87% now
- ◆ 86% a week ago
- ◆ 24% three months ago
- ◆ 44% a year ago

Statewide reservoir storage

Months of drought have begun to impact storage in our water supply reservoirs statewide. In late January, storage fell to 78 percent of capacity, 4 percentage points less than normal for this time of year and the lowest value since September 2018.
