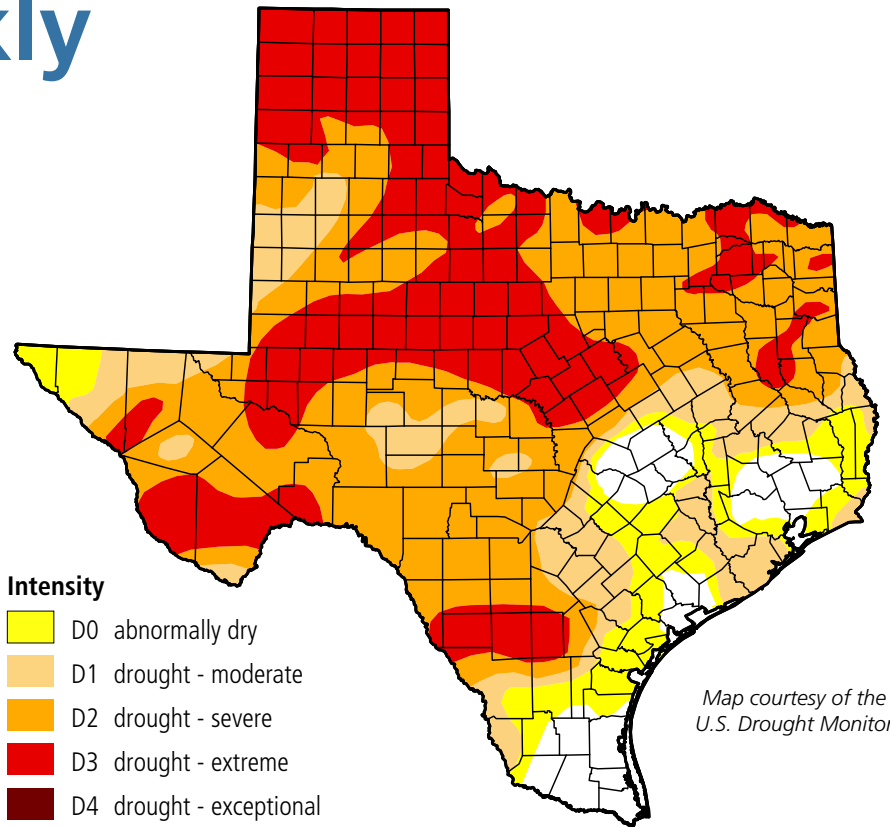

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of February 1 shows a decrease in the area of the state impacted by drought, the first decrease in 12 weeks. Additional rainfall in early February, primarily in Central and East Texas, should improve conditions further by the next report.

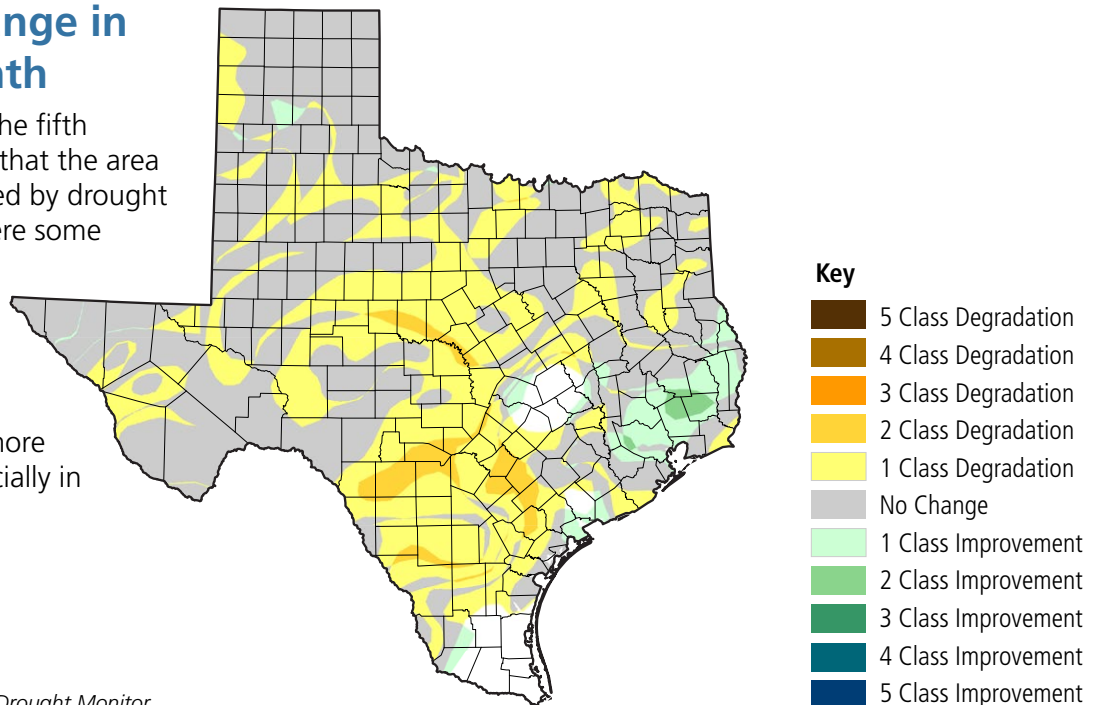
Drought conditions

- ◆ 84% now
- ◆ 87% a week ago
- ◆ 33% three months ago
- ◆ 45% a year ago



Drought change in the last month

January 2022 was the fifth consecutive month that the area of the state impacted by drought increased. There were some improvements in the last month, mostly in East Texas, while other parts of the state experienced more degradations, especially in Central Texas.
