



U.S. seasonal drought outlook

Compared to previous months, the National Weather Service is more optimistic regarding drought in Texas. Over the next few months, rainfall is expected to be sufficient to prevent drought expansion in East Texas. By the end of July, at least part of the state is expected to remain drought free.
