



Lubbock rainfall

From September 2021 to April 2022, Lubbock received 2.22 inches of precipitation, its lowest total for this time of year in more than 75 years, plunging the area into exceptional drought. So far in May 2022, Lubbock has received 3.58 inches of precipitation, helping to ease drought conditions.
