
Water Weekly For the week of 09/12/22

Water conditions

The latest drought map for September 6 shows widespread improvements across the state. For the first time in 2022, less than 75 percent of the state is in drought. Less than 1 percent of the state remains in exceptional drought, the smallest area since early March.


Drought conditions

- ♦ 62% now
- ♦ 76% a week ago
- ♦ 79% three months ago
- ♦ 0.5% a year ago



Statewide reservoir storage

From May through mid-August, statewide reservoir storage declined at a rate similar to 2011. Since mid-August, storage has increased almost 3 percentage points. Mid-September storage is 9 percentage points better than in 2011 but still 10 percentage points below normal for this time of year.
