

Extreme hydrologic drought

Hydrologic drought, based on 28-day average streamflow conditions, is impacting watersheds across the state. The most severely impacted watersheds include the Pecos River in West Texas; Nueces, Frio, Guadalupe, and Pedernales rivers in Central Texas; and the Navidad River along the coast.
